RE: CS for House Bill 395 (Rules)
"An Act relating to a homestead entry lottery."

This bill allows the Commissioner of DNR to conduct a homestead lottery in the community closest to the area designated for homestead entry and to require all applicants to be present to participate. The only exceptions would be persons who could not attend because of medical reasons, attendance at school, military service outside the state, or a mandatory, unavoidable employment commitment determined valid by the commissioner in advance.

The purpose is to make it more difficult for persons who are not local residents to participate. The bill has a zero fiscal note and is supported by the department. It passed the house 34 to 5.

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to a homestead entry lottery."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 38.09.010(g) is amended to read:

9 (g) The commissioner may limit the number of persons permitted
10 to stake homestead entries within an area designated under (a) of this
11 section by a lottery of qualified applicants. The commissioner may
12 conduct a lottery held under this subsection in the community that is
13 closest to the area designated for homestead entry. The commissioner
14 may require that each participant in the lottery be present at the
15 lottery unless medical reasons, attendance at school, or military
16 service outside the state prevent attendance.
