RE: HB 512 Relating to appointments to the boards  
of fisheries and game

HB 512 would require the governor to publish the names of proposed appointees to the Board of Fisheries and the Board of Game. At least 30 days before an appointment is made, the names must be published in newspapers in all sections of the state. The public shall have the opportunity to comment on the proposed appointees.

A further criterion for appointment is added that requires the appointee to have knowledge about allocation issues.
