6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making appropriations for the capital and
 7 loan program expenses of state government; making an
 8 appropriation from the housing assistance loan fund
 9 to the general fund; and providing for an effective
 10 date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. The sum of \$8,000,000 is appropriated from the general
 13 fund to the fisheries enhancement revolving loan fund (AS 16.10.505) for
 14 the fisheries enhancement loan programs.

15 * Sec. 2. The sum of \$7,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund
 16 to the Alaska Student Loan Corporation, student loan fund (AS 14.42.210),
 17 to capitalize the fund.

18 * Sec. 3. The sum of \$10,421,000 is appropriated to the Alaska clean
 19 water fund (AS 46.03.032) for the Alaska clean water loan program from the
 20 following sources:

21	General Fund	\$1,421,000
22	Federal Receipts	9,000,000

23 * Sec. 4. The sum of \$2,196,800 is appropriated from the housing assis-
 24 tance loan fund (AS 44.47.380) to the general fund.

25 * Sec. 5. The sum of \$300,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
 26 the Department of Community and Regional Affairs for payment as a grant
 27 under AS 37.05.316 to the Community Enterprise Development Corporation of
 28 Alaska to match federal Economic Development Administration funds for the
 29 economic development administration revolving boat loan fund for western

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Alaskan fishermen.

* Sec. 6. The sum of \$7,000,000 is appropriated from the Railbelt energy fund to the Department of Commerce and Economic Development, Alaska Power Authority, for construction of the Bradley Lake power project.

* Sec. 7. The unexpended and unobligated balance of the appropriation made by sec. 6 of this Act lapses into the Railbelt energy fund January 1, 1992.

* Sec. 8. The appropriations made by this Act are not one year appropriations and do not lapse under AS 37.25.010.

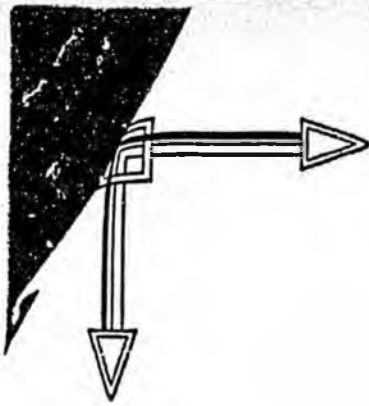

The Glenn Highway, from Mile 47 to Mile 62, is a substandard component of Alaska's Interstate Highway. Currently it has minimal driving lanes with no shoulders, despite the fact that much of the winding road has extremely steep drop-offs. School buses use this route and very hazardous conditions have occurred because of the lack of road shoulders. Public outcry has been great; there has been approximately 25 documentable accidents along this stretch of road during the past six years.

Potential coal development at Wishbone Hill, in Sutton, will only accentuate the problem. Exploration and permitting work will begin this summer. Bulk-sampling is anticipated with full development scheduled for 1991. This highway project's full reconstruction is not in the DOT six year plan at this time.

\$500,000 will create shoulders along some of the more critical portions of this section of the Glenn Highway.
