Re: "SB 205, An Act Relating to the Railbelt energy council and providing for an effective date"

The Railbelt Energy Council (REC) was created by the Legislature during the 1986 session. The Council was established to review various energy related issues and problems of the Railbelt and how best to utilize the Railbelt Energy Fund (REF). The Council was to report its recommendations to the Legislature by February 15, 1987.

The Council was of immense value to all 13 of its members. The legislators became well-versed with the Railbelt energy issues, while the utilities were able, for the first time, to forge a consensus on how best to address the Railbelt energy needs. The council completed its report on January 24, 1987 and transmitted its unanimous findings and recommendations to the legislature.

SB 205 will extend the Council for one year in order to monitor the implementation of its recommendations. In addition, it will provide the only formal mechanism for participation by the Railbelt utilities. The Council will report to the 1988 legislature on how well the recommendations are being implemented and whether there are any remaining problem areas.

In addition, SB 205 will add the Alaska Power Authority to the membership of the Council. The purpose is to make sure that all key players are officially represented in order to enable the Council to address the Railbelt energy issues in the most comprehensive and coordinated manner possible.
