5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making special appropriations to the Depart-
7 ment of Community and Regional Affairs for grants to
8 collect marine garbage; and providing for an effec-
9 tive date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the general fund
12 to the Department of Community and Regional Affairs, marine garbage collec-
13 tion fund, for grants under AS 44.47.750 to the following communities and
14 municipalities adjacent to Bristol Bay to alleviate marine garbage prob-
15 lems: Bristol Bay Borough, Togiak, Egegik, Pilot Point, Clark's
16 Point/Ekuk, and Dillingham.

17 * Sec. 2. The sum of \$100,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
18 the Department of Community and Regional Affairs, marine garbage collection
19 fund, for grants under AS 44.47.750 to communities and municipalities
20 adjacent to state water other than Bristol Bay to alleviate marine garbage
21 problems.

22 * Sec. 3. The unexpended and unobligated portion of the appropriations
23 made by this Act lapse June 30, 1989.

24 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the effective date of an Act that is
25 enacted by the Fifteenth Alaska State Legislature that establishes a marine
26 garbage collection fund.
