A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act changing the date the proposed general appro-
7 priation bill becomes public."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 37.07.020(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The governor shall prepare and submit to the legislature
11 before the fourth legislative day a budget for the succeeding fiscal
12 year that covers [WHICH SHALL COVER] all estimated receipts, including
13 all grants, loans, and money received from the federal government, and
14 all proposed expenditures of the state government. The budget sub-
15 mitted by the governor shall be organized so that the proposed ex-
16 penditures for each agency are presented separately. The budget shall
17 be accompanied by a general appropriation bill to authorize the
18 proposed expenditures, and a bill or bills covering recommendations in
19 the budget for new or additional revenues. The proposed general
20 appropriation bill shall become public information when it is sub-
21 mitted to the legislature or on February 1, whichever is earlier,
22 [DECEMBER 15 OF EACH YEAR] at which time the governor shall [SUBMIT
23 COPIES TO THE LEGISLATURE AND] make copies available to the public.
