BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS there are a number of school buildings in the state that have

9

historical significance, including Whitecliff School in Ketchikan, Capital

10

School in Juneau, Main School in Fairbanks, Akiak Elementary School in

11

Akiak, and Denali School in Anchorage; and

12

WHEREAS it is in the public interest that these buildings be preserved

13

whenever consistent with the health, safety, and educational interests of

14

the students served by the schools; and

15

WHEREAS inclusion of a school building in the National Register of

16

Historic Places may provide benefits to the building itself as well as the

17

public as owner of the building; and

18

WHEREAS a historical school building may sometimes be maintained by a

19

local school district only through financial assistance from the state; and

20

WHEREAS public assistance for historical schools serves the state as a

21

whole through the encouragement of tourism, the preservation of historic

22

identity and neighborhood vitality in areas of historical interest, and

23

through other public purposes; and

24

WHEREAS there is presently no comprehensive plan for providing assis-

25

tance to local school districts to preserve historical school buildings;

26

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is

27

respectfully requested to direct the commissioner of education to report to

28

the Second Session of the Fifteenth Alaska State Legislature, on or before

29

January 31, 1988, with regard to the following:

- 1           (1) which school buildings in the state that were constructed  
2 before statehood are still being used for educational purposes;
- 3           (2) the condition and anticipated useful life of each of these  
4 buildings;
- 5           (3) whether the school districts operating these buildings  
6 intend to continue operating them as schools;
- 7           (4) what steps the state might take to encourage the continued  
8 operation of these buildings as schools;
- 9           (5) the nature of the benefits, if any, that accrue to the  
10 owners of a building that is included in the National Register of Historic  
11 Places; and
- 12          (6) if a school district is planning to close a historical  
13 school building, what compatible public uses the district might make of  
14 portions of the building in order to perpetuate the useful life of the  
15 building for educational purposes.
