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CS HJR 63 (Resources) SENATE RESOURCES LETTER OF INTENT

It is the intent of the Legislature in passing CS HJR 63 (Resources) that the "raw fish tax" described in the resolution be applied to processors and not be misconstrued to be applied to fisherman fishing in federal waters.

By a domestic on-board observer program, the Legislature is not intending to promote a program with on-board observers on every small boat fishing in federal waters. Rather, the purpose of a domestic on-board observer program is to provide coverage on boats with a substantial impact on the targeted species and species harvested as by-catch.

It is not the intent of the Legislature that an imposition of a federal raw fish tax in the area between three miles and 200 miles would cause any negative impact on the State of Alaska or any of its coastal communities that may impose a raw fish tax.
