**JUNE 17, 1988**

**HARVEY CUSHING, M.D., DAY**

Dr. Harvey Cushing is being honored nationally this year as "a great American" with the issuance of the Harvey Cushing, M.D. commemorative stamp. The stamp will be released on June 17th, 1988.

Neurological societies nationally are requesting their state legislatures to proclaim June 17, 1988 as Harvey Cushing Day to coincide with the stamp's issuance and to further honor America's foremost pioneer in the practice of neurological surgery.

Dr. Cushing, while a physician at John Hopkin's Medical University, pioneered modern methods of brain and spinal cord surgery. He became known as the father of neurological surgery internationally for his laboratory investigations and clinical applications of neurological surgery.

Prior to Dr. Cushing's surgical developments, the course of central nervous system diseases could not be altered and were usually fatal. With the new methods, patients with neurological disorders frequently benefit from surgery and return to normal life.

Dr. Cushing's contributions to the medical community, many Americans, and countless internationally have dramatically improved our way of life and is deserving of the national recognition he is now receiving.
