
IT IS THE INTENT OF THE LEGISLATURE THAT:

A) ANY FUNDS EXPENDED FROM THE OIL AND HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE RELEASE RESPONSE FUND WHICH PAY FOR THE REGULAR SALARIES OF STATE AGENCY PERSONNEL SHALL RESULT IN AN EQUIVALENT LAPSE OF MONEYS TO THE GENERAL FUND FROM THAT AGENCY;

B) ANY OTHER AGENCY OPERATIONS FUNDED BY THE APPROPRIATIONS MADE IN HCS CS SB 247 (FINANCE), IF NOT OFFSET BY AN EQUIVALENT LAPSE, SHALL NOT BE PART OF THE "ADJUSTED BASE" CALCULATION IN CONSIDERATION OF THE FY 90 AND THE FY 91 BUDGETS; AND

C) THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW WILL PURSUE THE RECOVERY OF ALL COSTS INCURRED IN RESPONDING TO THE VALDEZ EXXON OIL SPILL, AND EVERY ATTEMPT WILL BE MADE TO EXPEND PROGRAM RECEIPTS RECEIVED FROM EXXON OR OTHER SOURCES PRIOR TO THE EXPENDITURE OF GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 \* Section 1. The sum of \$10,000,000 is appropriated from the general  
13 fund to the oil and hazardous substance release response fund (AS 46.08.-  
14 010) for expenditures necessitated by the state response to the oil spill  
15 from the Exxon Valdez.

16 \* Sec. 2. The sum of \$10,000,000 is appropriated, subject to the con-  
17 ditions of sec. 3 of this Act, from the general fund or general fund pro-  
18 gram receipts to the oil and hazardous substance release response fund  
19 (AS 46.08.010) for expenditures necessitated by the state response to the  
20 oil spill from the Exxon Valdez.

21 \* Sec. 3. The appropriation made by sec. 2 of this Act is contingent  
22 upon compliance with AS 37.07.080(h) as if the funds appropriated were  
23 other program receipts not specifically appropriated by the full legisla-  
24 ture.

25 \* Sec. 4. The unexpended and unobligated balance of the appropriations  
26 made by this Act that exceeds \$2,000,000 on January 31, 1990, is trans-  
27 ferred to the general fund.

28 \* Sec. 5. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).

LETTER OF INTENT

To: HCS CSSB 247 (FIAI)

It is the intent of the legislature that:

- a) any funds expended from the oil and hazardous substance release response fund which pay for the regular salaries of state agency personnel shall result in an equivalent lapse of moneys to the general fund from that agency; and
- b) any other agency operations funded by the appropriations in HCS CSSB 247, <sup>(FIAI)</sup> if not offset by an equivalent lapse, shall not be part of the "adjusted base" calculation in consideration of the FY '90 ~~or~~ <sup>and the</sup> FY '91 budgets.


