page 2, beginning at line 2, insert and replace into subsections (b), (c), (d), (e) and (f):

\* Sec. 2. (b) The Subsistence Review Commission consists of nine members appointed by the governor, to include

- (1) a representative of each of the following:
  - (A) the Board of Fisheries or the Board of Game,
  - (B) the Fish and Game regional council system,
  - (C) organizations representing
    - (i) Alaska Natives,
    - (ii) sportsmen's groups and
    - (iii) commercial fishing interests, and
- (2) four public members, each public member appointed from a different judicial district, one of whom shall be a subsistence user.

(c) The speaker of the house of representatives, or the speaker's designee, and the president of the senate, or the president's designee, shall serve as ex officio, non-voting members of the commission.

(d) A majority of the commission constitutes a quorum for conducting official business of the commission.

(e) The governor may appoint additional non-voting, ex-officio members representing state and federal agencies.

(f) Members of the commission who are not state or federal employees are entitled to transportation and per diem expenses as provided in AS 39.20.180.

**\*Sec. 2. (a) There is established in the Department of Fish and Game the Commission on Subsistence Use of Fish and Game. The commission consists of nine voting members. [The voting members of the commission serve without compensation, but are entitled to per diem and travel expenses authorized for boards and commission under AS 39.20.180.] Voting members of the commission serve until the repeal of this Act as provided under sec. 3 of this act.**


