

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act making special appropriations to the oil and hazardous substance release response fund for oil spill expenditures and making a transfer of excess funds to the general fund; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of ^{RU: 10,000,000}~~\$5,000,000~~ is appropriated from the general fund to the oil and hazardous substance release response fund (AS 46.08.-010) for expenditures necessitated by the state response to the oil spill from the Exxon Valdez. _{DP: Moved}

* Sec. 2. The sum of ^{RU: 10,000,000}~~\$15,000,000~~ is appropriated from general fund program receipts to the oil and hazardous substance release response fund (AS 46.08.010) for expenditures necessitated by the state response to the oil spill from the Exxon Valdez. _{DP: Moved}

* Sec. 3. The balance of the oil and hazardous substance release response fund (AS 46.08.010) on ^{JD: June 30, 1989}~~July 1, 1989~~, that exceeds ^{2,000,000}~~\$5,000,000~~ is transferred to the general fund. _{DP: Moved}

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately under with AS 01.10.070(c).
