9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the Cordova maintenance station is currently part of the
11 Central Region of the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities;
12 and

13 WHEREAS the City of Cordova and its residents have repeatedly ex-
14 pressed dissatisfaction with the Department of Transportation and Public
15 Facilities' maintenance operations in Cordova, as reflected in matters such
16 as inadequate staffing and the lack of a budget for the Cordova maintenance
17 station; and

18 WHEREAS the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities' North-
19 ern Region has stated a desire to assume responsibility for the Cordova
20 maintenance station, and has stated that it would provide a budget for the
21 Cordova station manager; and

22 WHEREAS the commissioner of transportation and public facilities has
23 decided to retain the Cordova maintenance station as part of the Central
24 Region;

25 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the governor is
26 respectfully requested to direct the commissioner of transportation and
27 public facilities to reconsider the decision and to transfer the Cordova
28 maintenance station to the Department of Transportation and Public Facili-
29 ties' Northern Region.
