A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act providing for an advisory vote on access to basic health care for all Alaskans;
2 and providing for an effective date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. The lieutenant governor shall place before the qualified voters of the state at the next
5 general election the question advisory to the legislature of whether the legislature should enact a law
6 providing for access to basic health care for all Alaskans. The question shall appear on the ballot in
7 substantially the following form:

8 Q U E S T I O N

9 Health care costs in the state have risen dramatically in the last
10 decade even though there are many Alaskans who do not have access to
11 basic health care. Providing access to basic health care for all Alaskans
12 will require financial contributions from individual Alaskans or expenditure
13 of money from the state general fund.

I would appreciate it very much if you would schedule HB 460 for a hearing before your committee as soon as possible. This is an extremely simple bill which places before the voters the question "Shall the Alaska State Legislature enact a law that would make health care available to all state residents?"

I think that it is important to get a reading from the voters on whether this is an issue of great concern, as we, as legislators, all seem to think. Recent constituent surveys taken by several legislators have found that this is not an area of major concern in their districts. It would be helpful to us to get a reading statewide on this issue before we begin the long, painful, and costly process of crafting a health care plan for all Alaskans.

I would appreciate an expeditious hearing on this bill.

At a recent meeting of the Alaska State Medical Association Legislative Affairs Committee, your House Bill 460 was discussed. This bill would provide an advisory vote on State-wide health care. This bill was strongly supported. As you know, the medical association has been instrumental in developing the Comprehensive Health Insurance and Payment Reform Act of 1992 (CHIPRA) which, indeed, would make health care available for all State residents.

I would suggest that the ballot language be expanded to ask the voters if they would approve of monies from Permanent Fund Dividends being used to help pay for health insurance coverage.
