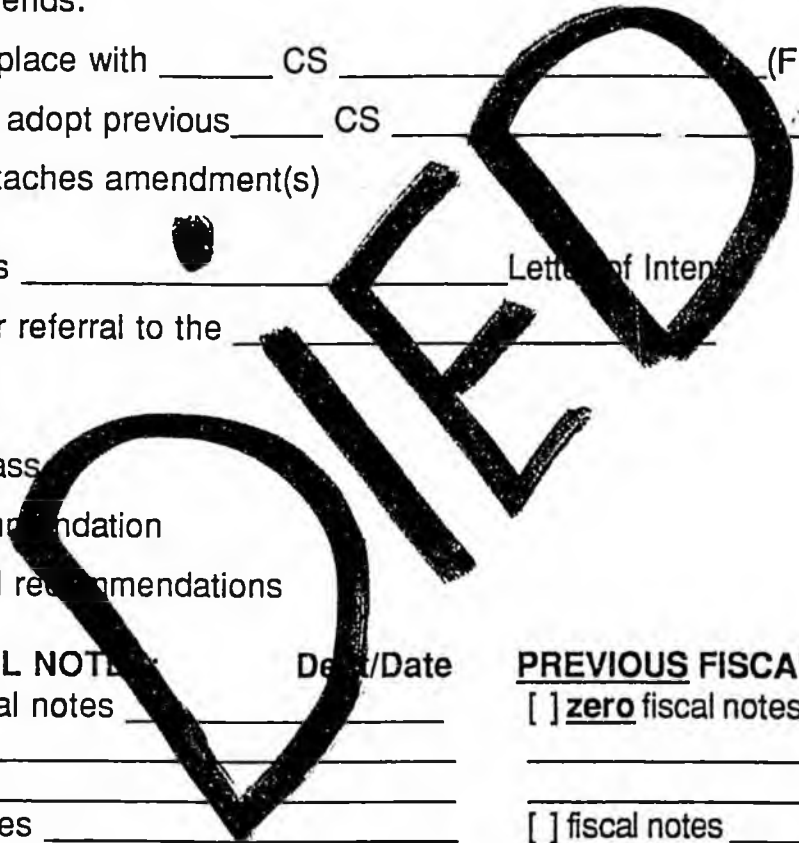

A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to an alcohol server education course."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 04.21 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 Sec. 04.21.025. ALCOHOL SERVER EDUCATION COURSE. (a) As a condition of
 5 issuance or renewal of a license and selling alcoholic beverages under a license, the board shall
 6 require : licensee who sells or serves alcoholic beverages and a licensee's agents and employees
 7 who sell or serve alcoholic beverages to complete an alcohol server education course approved
 8 by the board, if the license is for a

- 9 (1) beverage dispensary;
 10 (2) restaurant or eating place;
 11 (3) club;
 12 (4) package store;
 13 (5) common carrier dispensary;
 14 (6) recreational site;

- 1 (7) community;
- 2 (8) pub;
- 3 (9) conditional contractor.

4 (b) The subjects that are included in an approved alcohol server education course shall
5 be determined under regulations adopted by the board. In approving alcohol server education
6 courses, the board shall consider the needs of both urban and rural licensees regarding access to
7 an approved alcohol server education course. A licensee, agent, or employee who sells or serves
8 alcoholic beverages shall keep proof acceptable to the board of successful completion of an
9 approved alcohol server education course on the licensed premises during working hours.

10 (c) A licensee, agent, or employee shall complete the course required under (a) of this
11 section not more than 30 days after being licensed or employed.

12 (d) The board shall review an approved alcohol server education course at least once
13 every three years.

14 * Sec. 2. TRANSITION. Notwithstanding AS 04.21.025(c), enacted in sec. 1 of this Act, a licensee,
15 agent, or employee who is required to complete a course under AS 04.21.025(a), enacted in sec. 1 of
16 this Act, shall complete the course not more than 30 days after the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board
17 approves alcohol server education courses for both urban and rural licensees.
