1 "An Act providing for an advisory vote on the issue of capital punishment; and providing
 2 for an effective date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. The lieutenant governor shall place before the qualified voters of the state at the next
 5 general election the question advisory to the legislature of whether the legislature should enact a law
 6 providing for capital punishment for murder in the first degree. The question shall appear on the ballot
 7 in substantially the following form:

8 Q U E S T I O N

9 Shall the Alaska State Legislature enact a law providing for capital punishment
 10 for murder in the first degree and establishing procedures for the imposition of capital
 11 punishment that are consistent with the United States Constitution as interpreted by the
 12 United States Supreme Court?
