Proposed Amendment by Senator Pearce to Work Draft SCS CSHB 574 (L&C)

Page 7, line 21

Add the following sentence immediately after "...operations in the state."

No regulatory cost charge may be assessed to pipeline carrier operations which are not jurisdictional to the commission.

This amendment confirms that only pipeline carrier operations which are subject to the jurisdiction of the Alaska Public Utilities Commission are subject to the regulatory cost charge established by AS 42.06.285.

Amend #2

Proposed Amendment to Workdraft SCS CSHB 574(L&C)

page 8, line 10:

[paid] borne by the pipeline carrier or shipper under AS 42.06.285.

This language would require the commission to take account of costs paid by shippers including refiners, under the regulatory cost charge program.

Proposed Amendment to Work Draft SCS CSHB 574 (L&C)

The legislature finds that fairness requires that the regulatory cost charge be paid only once on a given dollar of gross revenue. No utility or pipeline carrier may be required to pay the regulatory cost charge assessed to gross revenues which have already been assessed the regulatory cost charge under either AS 42.05.253(a) or AS 42.06.285(a).

Page 5, line 24

delete "and under AS 42.06.285(a)"

Page 5, line 26

delete "and pipeline carriers"

These amendments prevent cross-subsidization in the use of regulatory cost charges. User fees paid by utilities may be used only for services to public utilities.

Page 7, line 24

delete "and under AS 42.05.253(a)"

delete "public utilities and"

These amendments accomplish the same purpose described above.
