MEMORANDUM

TO: ALL SENATORS
FROM: SENATOR SHULTZ *DS*
DATE: FEBRUARY 4, 1991
RE: SUPPORTING HUNTING, FISHING & TRAPPING

As we all know the subsistence question has been very controversial. Because of all the attention focused on the issue, many of my constituents are concerned that we in the legislature may be ignoring the larger problems faced by all Alaskans who hunt, fish, or trap.

The resolution I am introducing, seeks to reaffirm the legislature's support for these traditional Alaskan activities. Further, it enunciates our resolve in protecting age old cultures which are under attack both by animal protectionists groups, and a particular federal agency.

Finally, the resolution recognizes the importance of wise conservation of our renewable resources through professional fish and wildlife management.

It is my hope that all parties will step forward to support this resolution and bring Alaskans together as we meet the larger challenges looming on the horizon.


