A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to eligibility for permanent fund dividends; and providing for an effective
2 date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. AS 43.23.015(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) The commissioner shall adopt regulations under the Administrative Procedure Act
6 (AS 44.62) for determining the eligibility of individuals for permanent fund dividends. The
7 commissioner may require an individual to provide proof of eligibility, and the commissioner
8 may use other information available from other state departments or agencies to determine the
9 eligibility of an individual. However, the residency of an individual's spouse may not be the
10 only factor relied upon by the commissioner in determining the residency of the individual.

11 * Sec. 2. This Act is retroactive to January 1, 1992.

12 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
