During the last legislative session two identical bills were introduced into the House and the Senate, HB351 and SB309, respectively. We are asking to change one of the proposals, specifically, the change to AS 45.75.080(a) which deals with the frequency of the testing of weights and measures.

Rather than leave the frequency of the inspection to the discretion of the director, the law should remain the same as it has been for years, that is to require semiannual inspections of all weighing and measuring devices. Therefore, we propose to change the language on page one, beginning on line 7 to read as follows:

"The director shall, [AS] at least semiannually and more often as considered necessary...
