My move to Alaska was prompted by a long-standing interest in frontier life developed when I was a youth. I was further stimulated when I subscribed to the Alaska Sportsmans Magazine (now the Alaska Magazine) in my early adult life. The pioneering spirit of the people of Alaska, the beauty and vastness of the land, and the feeling that the individual could be heard and/or make an impact on the community rather than to be one of the inaudible voices in the crowd was compelling to me.

When an opportunity presented itself to have an immediate income and additional benefits for my family and myself, it seemed the appropriate time to make our move. The children were young enough to adjust with the least amount of trauma and, as our middle son was diagnosed as having Hodgkin's Disease (lymphnode cancer), it appeared to be a "now or never" situation. My wife and I agreed it was a minimum risk opportunity with maximum advantages for the entire family.

After passing the Alaska Dental Board examination, selling my dental practice and my residence in Illinois, my family and I adopted Alaska as our home state in August of 1976 and have never regretted our decision.

I have a very strong desire to serve as a member of the Alaska Dental Board and am anxious to contribute a fresh perspective by:

enhancing the efforts of Governor Hickel on his alternative medical/dental platform,

creating a balance between orthodox dentistry and that of biocompatible dentistry,

introducing the necessity for all Alaskans to have freedom of choice of the dental materials implanted in their teeth,

suggesting that Alaskans have the intelligence to select between biocompatible and potentially harmful materials being placed in their bodies,

contributing my enthusiasm and desire to be involved in keeping Alaska a leader in dental health issues.

REQUIREMENTS: LEGISLATIVE CONFIRMATION

PROHIBITIONS: Cannot serve more than all or part of two consecutive terms.

TERM: 4 years

DESCRIPTION: 9 members appointed by Governor: 6 licensed dentists who have engaged in the practice of dentistry in the state for 5 years immediately preceding appointment; 2 dental hygienists who have engaged in the practice of dental hygiene in the state for 5 years immediately preceding appointment; 1 public member; terms begin on February 1.

SPECIAL FACTS: Quorum - majority; serve at the pleasure of the Governor; annual report to Governor. Members serve until a successor is appointed. An appointment to fill a vacancy is for the remainder of the unexpired term. A member who has served all or part of two successive terms may not be reappointed unless four years have elapsed since the person has last served.

FUNCTION: Regulates and controls licensing, permits, revocations of the dental profession.

COMPENSATION: Standard travel and per diem.

MEETINGS: At the call of the chair, at least 4 times per year.

## Employment History

1976-1980 U. S. Public Health Service, Indian Health Service, Alaska Native Medical Center. Commissioned Officer. Duties included all phases of general dental care in addition to specialty dental care in the areas of orthodontics, pedodontics, endodontics, and oral surgery. In addition hospital inpatient care was provided in the operating room and follow-up on the wards. Post-graduate training provided to me in this institution as a general practice resident in 1976 and 1977 included hospital rotations through all major medical specialty departments. From 1976 to 1980 I served as an itinerant staff dentist with this program, providing dental service in various communities around the State of Alaska including Tyonek, Kenai, Pt Lions, Ouzinkie (pre-electricity), Newhalen (pre running water), Wasilla, Nondalton, and Barrow. During this time I developed and implemented an ongoing preventive dental health care program for Alaska Native and American Indian children residing in the greater Anchorage area that to my knowledge is still the largest program of its type in the State today. From 1976 to 1980 I was responsible for the dental needs of 20 to 40 Native children in residence at Hope Cottages. I performed dental assessments, examinations and oral screenings at Hope Cottage, then made logistical arrangements for the children requiring various dental treatments which I would provide or arrange for at the hospital.

During this time I provided training and information to the Dental Hygiene Program of the Anchorage Community College, as well as various village health aides throughout the state. I provided supervised instruction at ANMC for participants in the Commissioned Officers Students Training Extern Program (COSTEP). The program is designed to orient graduate level students to the Commissioned Officer Service. The major emphasis of this program is to assist the students in experiencing various dental procedures and techniques.

In 1979 through a contract with the State of Alaska I worked with the Division of Corrections providing dental care for juvenile offenders at McLaughlin Youth Center.

1980 to Present - Southcentral Foundation, Anchorage, AK

I am currently the Director of Clinical Services (includes Dental, Optometry and Women's Health Care Screening Clinic Services) for Southcentral Foundation, the non-profit health corporation of CIRI. I was originally chosen to develop and direct the dental program in 1980 by CIRI through Cook Inlet Native Association. Since its inception I have taken a 3 chair dental program with a staff of three and progressed to a 6 operatory clinic with a staff of 12. We are the greatest provider of specialty dental services (eg Crown and Bridge, Dentures, ) to the Alaska Native community. The services we commonly provide were previously largely unavailable through the direct IHS dental facilities due to budgeting and personnel constraints. In addition to direct clinical services I provide management for the dental program and share teaching responsibility with the General Practice Residency program at the ANMC. The senior resident in this program is detailed to my clinic to learn advanced prosthodontic techniques. I am on the visiting professional staff at ANMC and am often asked to speak at their local and area dental meetings. My clinic was the first "638" contract dental clinic in the state and it serves as a model to other "638" organizations. I have frequently been called on by similar programs to recommend staff, equipment, and computer systems to help set up new programs. I work with a wide variety of patients many of whom speak little English. I have worked and traveled extensively in Alaska. I have an excellent sense of the importance of dentistry in the State and would be honored to serve on the Board.
