RE: Scheduling of SJR31--relating to the minimum federal
criteria for municipal solid waste landfills

I request that SJR31 be referred and scheduled for passage in the House. It passed the Senate today on a 19-0 vote.

SJR31 requests the federal government to extend the deadline for meeting federal criteria for municipal solid waste landfills an additional two years. The current deadline is October 9, 1993.

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation will have difficulty meeting this deadline for implementation of its new solid waste program. Additionally, it is working with the EPA on a small communities exemption provision. It needs more time for both efforts.
