1 "An Act relating to an advisory vote during regional educational attendance area  
2 school board elections; and providing for an effective date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 \* Section 1. AS 14.08.071 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (d) If a regional school board adopts a resolution requesting that an advisory  
6 question relating to education be placed on that regional school board's next election  
7 ballot, the division of elections shall place the advisory question on that regional  
8 school board's next election ballot. A resolution described in this subsection must be  
9 filed with the division of elections on or before the first Friday in August of the year  
10 in which the advisory question is required to be placed on the ballot. An advisory  
11 question authorized under this subsection may not consist of more than 100 words and  
12 shall be worded in a manner that allows the advisory question to be answered with a  
13 "yes" or "no."

14 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1995.

## SPONSOR STATEMENT

### SB 18

This bill adds a provision in statute which would allow communities in Regional Education Attendance Area (REAA) school districts to be able to voice their positions on education related issues of concern to them via an advisory vote on the regular school ballot. REAA school sites are typically spread over a large area and it is often difficult for members of the community to attend school board meetings and make their feelings known. This bill allows the school board to adopt a resolution requesting that an advisory question be placed on the next ballot. They then get a certified count from the communities regarding the issue.

This bill passed the Senate and died in the House Rules Committee during the Eighteenth Alaska Legislature.
