SPONSOR STATEMENT

DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS HB 72 "AN ACT RELATING TO AN ASSISTANT ADJUTANT GENERAL FOR SPACE AND MISSILE DEFENSE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS' AFFAIRS

The purpose of this bill is to establish an Assistant Adjutant General for space and missile Defense. The position would be authorized for the duration of the development and deployment of a missile defense system in Alaska. The position will be federally funded.

Only the legislature has the authority to create positions of Assistant Adjutant General. Currently, the department is authorized an Assistant Adjutant General for the Army National Guard and an Assistant Adjutant General for the Air National Guard. In addition, confirmation of all general officers is the prerogative of the legislature. The person selected for this position will come before the legislature to be confirmed as a general officer.

The Assistant Adjutant General for Space and Missile Defense will be a member of the Alaska National Guard in traditional status (part-time). In this capacity, the position will report to the Adjutant General of the State of Alaska and be assigned duties by the Adjutant General.

Concurrently, the Assistant Adjutant General for Space and Missile Defense may also report to the Program Executive Officer and System Program Director of the Missile Defense Joint Program Office in the role of Commander of the Site Activation Command in Alaska.

This position will keep the Adjutant General informed at all times of the progress in developing and deploying a space and missile defense program in Alaska. The

department believes that establishing this joint position will allow the Alaska National Guard to fully meet Alaskan interests in the fielding and operation of a space and missile defense system in Alaska.

I would like to amend the title and body of HB 72 and SB 39 from "An Act relating to an assistant adjutant general for national missile defense" to "An Act relating to an assistant adjutant general for space and missile defense".

This change is needed in order to be consistent with changing terminology on the national level and because it more clearly relates to the full range of programs this position will oversee. Nationally, the discussion around a national missile defense system is becoming more expansive and the term of missile defense is seen as being inclusive of national as well as theater missile defense.

In addition, the federal missions for the Alaska National Guard are beginning to include roles in Space Surveillance and air sovereignty as well as missile defense reaching into space. DMVA is very likely to have considerable involvement with space surveillance at Clear, Regional Air Operations at Elemendorf and military launches at the Kodiak launch facility.

Presently, HB 72 is in the House Rules Committee and SB 39 is in Senate Finance. HB 72 has a floor manager identified and has been requested for the floor. SB 39 has a hearing request but not yet scheduled.
