2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 **\* Section 1.** AS 28.10.181 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

4 (x) Special request benevolent association plates. Upon application by the  
5 owner of a motor vehicle, the department may design and issue registration plates  
6 representing a benevolent association to which AS 21.72 applies. The department may  
7 disapprove the issuance of registration plates under this subsection when the requested  
8 plates are a duplication of an existing registration.
