4 **\* Section 1.** AS 28.10.181 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

5 (z) Special request active fire fighter and emergency medical service provider  
6 plates, former fire fighter and emergency medical service provider plates, and plates  
7 commemorating fire fighters and emergency medical service providers. On application  
8 by the owner of a motor vehicle, the department may issue registration plates for  
9 active fire fighters and emergency medical service providers, registration plates for  
10 former fire fighters and emergency medical service providers, and registration plates  
11 commemorating fire fighters and emergency medical service providers. The  
12 commissioner shall determine the design and color of the plates. The department may  
13 disapprove the issuance of registration plates under this subsection when the requested  
14 plates are a duplication of an existing registration. To be eligible for

Page 1 line 5 - per Legal Services: there was another subsection added last year to statute so the subsection number changes from "(y)" to "(z)".

Page 2 Line 30 changes the effective date from 2009 to 2010.

I know this is late in coming, but I have several questions regarding the draft CS for HB 73:

1. Are volunteer fire fighters and EMS providers covered under this bill?
2. What sort of proof would an active fire fighter or EMS provider show to the DMV to prove that they are active? Technically under this bill, an individual could be a firefighter or EMS provider for a month and get this license plate so long as they provide proof that they are active at the time of registration. Correct?
3. What sort of proof would a former fire fighter or EMS provider show to the DMV to prove that they were an active member for 10 years?
4. Is there a particular group that Rep. Lynn envisions the DMV working with in order to develop a plate design?
5. Anyone could get the commemorative fire fighter and EMS provider plate so long as they pay the initial \$100 fee and the biennial fee of \$35. Correct?

Sure Nancy -

1. Yes - both paid and volunteer are covered under this bill.
2. We would develop a form (approved by DMV) that fire chiefs would issue to members and former members, upon request that would verify that they were active or former members in good standing of a fire department or ems service. I imagine that the chiefs we have on board here in the state of Alaska have good enough judgement to not give someone the said form until they have been on board for more than a month as the training necessary to even perform either of these duties is quite extensive and they (the chiefs) may have their own "built-in" rules regarding when they consider "active member". In my department you have to attend so many meetings a year, so many trainings, calls, etc. to be considered an active member. If someone comes to a community from "outside" and were active in their departments and then joined a department here, they would still have to meet the departments definition of "active" before they would get the form from the chief.
3. The former member would get a form signed by his former chief/department, documenting his service - these records are pretty well kept due to the amount of training required to perform these duties.
4. We have a plate design that we have on standby - it was developed by the fire service statewide last year.
5. Yes - it is a community members way of supporting the fire service.
