Senate Concurrent Resolution 14: "Filipino American History Month"

Senate Concurrent Resolution 14 intends to dedicate October as Filipino American History Month in Alaska, commemorating the contributions of Filipino-Americans to the history and heritage of our state and nation.

Filipinos have a rich history and culture in Alaska. The first recorded Filipino in Alaska came aboard a ship from the Philippines in 1788. In early Alaska history, Filipinos worked on whaling ships, in the Alaska-Juneau and Treadwell mines, and in the canneries. The Filipino-American community now is the largest Asian-American group in Alaska, with 18,000 people.

Filipinos enrich our history and heritage. I've introduced Senate Resolution 14 to celebrate October 2010 as Filipino American History Month in Alaska. I urge your support of this legislation.
