Dear Alaska House Representatives:

On behalf myself and the Anchorage Fire Department, I would like to offer my support of House Bill 73 which provides for Firefighter and Emergency Service Provider License Plates.

Having such a license plate would allow for immediate recognition on the scene of an accident or any other emergency situation which would ultimately save valuable time getting through to the site.

Also, a large portion of Alaskan communities are served by volunteer firefighters and emergency medical technicians that routinely leave their family and jobs day or night to provide service to their local communities and assist their neighbors in their time of need. Having a specialized license plate would provide them recognition for the sacrifice they make – much like those recognizing our Veterans.

This is an excellent idea and I would like to thank you for considering this addition to House Bill 73.
