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How HB 73 Changed from Version A to Version S in House STA

In the House State Affairs Committee:

Firefighter and Emergency Service Providers License Plates were added to the bill at the request of Representative Harris. Later, all references to Honorary Consul License Plates were removed retaining just the Firefighter and Emergency Service Providers License Plates.

How CSHB 73 Changed from Version S to Version C in House FIN

Page 1 line 5 - per Legal Services: there was another subsection added last year to statute so the subsection number changes from "(y)" to "(z)".

Page 2 Line 30 changes the effective date from 2009 to 2010.
