BILL NO. SB 175 _____

Analysis

SB 175 adds legislative findings to the uncodified law of the State of Alaska and amends AS 44.09 with a new section that designates the Winchester pre-1964 Model 70 as the official state bolt-action rifle due to the historical significance to early pioneers of Alaska.

This official designation is purely symbolic and will have no budget or service impact. Therefore the Department of Administration, Office of the Commissioner submits a zero fiscal note.
