I respectfully request a hearing on Senate Bill 154 in the House State Affairs Committee at your earliest convenience.

SB 154 creates an opportunity for Alaskans to express support for the Blood Bank of Alaska by creating a special license plate for purchase at the Division of Motor Vehicles. The balance of the fees in excess to costs then would be available for appropriation to the Blood Bank of Alaska by the state legislature.

The Senate State Affairs Committee adopted a committee substitute to address a drafting oversight to include a provision requiring the Department of Administration to separately account for the fees collected from Blood Bank license plates, and then allowing the legislature to appropriate the balance to the Blood Bank of Alaska.

Senate Bill 154 passed the Senate by a vote of 17-1.
