Sponsor Statement

February 23, 2015

Unmanned aircraft systems (UAS) are beginning to fill our skies. Military, government, businesses and especially hobbyists are increasingly employing the fast-evolving technology as the units become more affordable. One brand of UAS reports more than 10,000 of one model are purchased every month in the United States.

Established in 1936, the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) is a community-based organization that continues to work with the FAA to establish safety guidelines and best practices for hobbyists engaging in the sport of recreational remote control flying. The AMA hosts a wide range of services for the betterment of the sport including flying competitions and stunt events, education seminars, publications, skill development of model aeronautics, and comradery amongst enthusiasts.

This resolution reflects the desire of the legislature in supporting the Academy of Model Aeronautics as the leading community-based organization for the establishment of recreational flight safety guidelines and best practices.

The legislature also recognizes the AMA for promotes privacy considerations for recreational pilots.

Explanation of Changes February 23, 2015

The bill title was changed to recognize the safety guidelines and best practices that are developed and promoted by the Academy of Model Aeronautics.

Page 2, line 1 includes the recognition that the AMA "established safety standards and best practices"

Page 2, line 14, includes "that promotes industry and community safety guidelines and best practices"

A conceptual amendment was also passed in House Transportation Committee that added to the list in individuals to be sent a copy of the resolution. Every organization that is mentioned in the resolution will receive a copy of the resolution.

The floor amendment added language to the recognition that the AMA also encourages recreational pilots to be responsible to concerns of personal privacy.

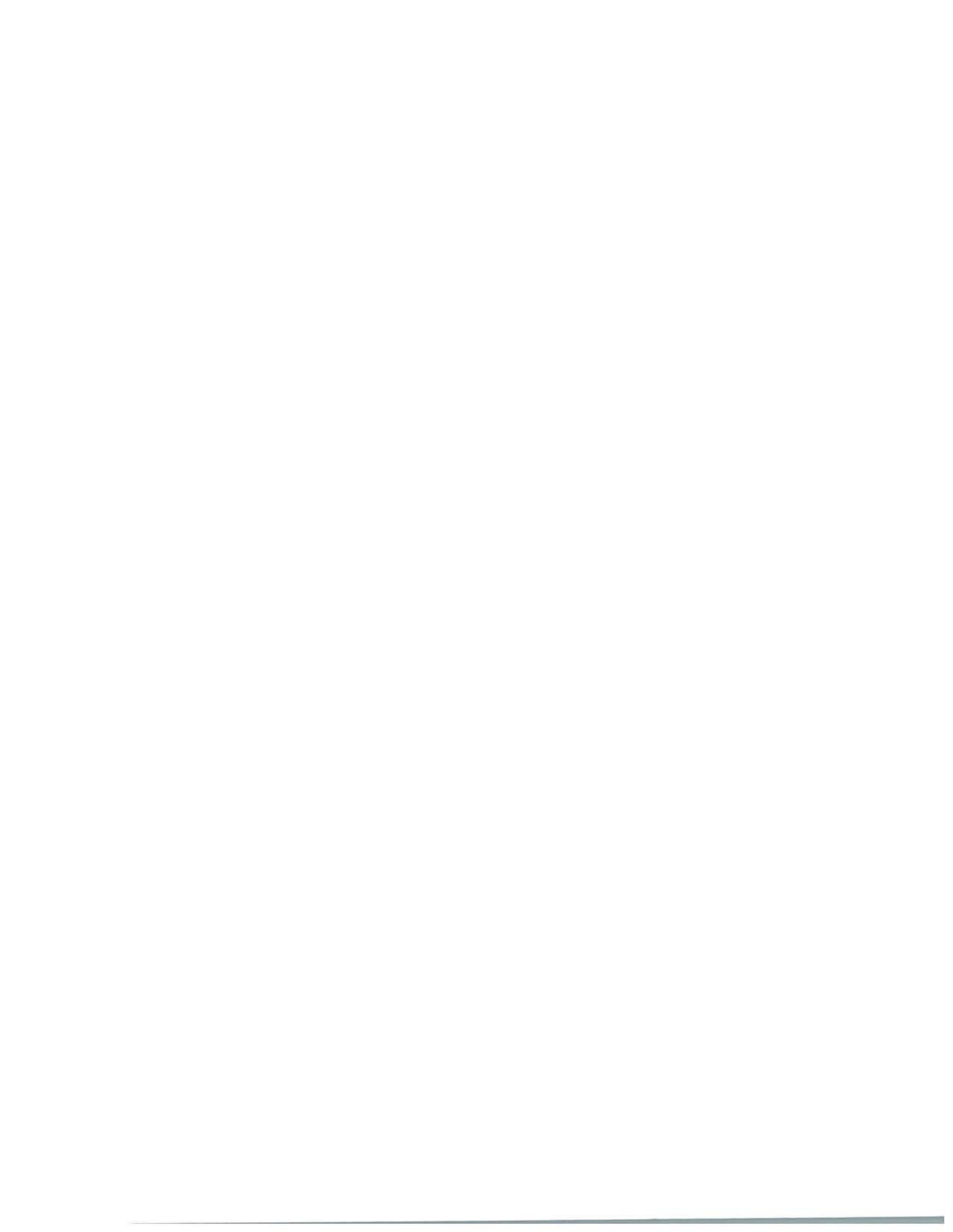
