This annual report is presented by the Alaska Public Defender Agency as required by AS 18.85.160(b). The Public Defender Agency provides legal representation for indigent defendants who are formally charged with the commission of crimes. That representation includes court appearances, pre-trial investigation and preparation; extradition hearings, violation of probation hearings, sanity hearings, and post-conviction relief hearings. Additionally, convicted indigent defendants and juvenile offenders are represented on appeal to the Supreme Court of Alaska; and, in some instances, they are represented on appeal to the United States Supreme Court.

The Agency is administered by the Alaska State Public Defender, nominated by the Judicial Council and appointed by the Governor, with legislative confirmation, for a term of four years. Structurally, the office is composed of a headquarters at Anchorage and four regional offices.

The attached statistics, required by statute, indicate an increase of 566 cases in the calendar year 1971 over the previous calendar year. During the year 1971, the Agency represented 461 more adults than the previous year, and juvenile cases increased by 101. A much greater increase will undoubtedly follow in the year 1972 because of the recent Supreme Court decision in Alexander v. Anchorage. In that case, the Supreme Court of Alaska ruled that indigent defendants charged with misdemeanors, carrying penalties that could result in imprisonment, high fines, or loss of valuable license, are entitled to court-appointed counsel. Following the decision of November 19, 1971, in Anchorage alone, 219 cases were added to the Agency caseload for the balance of the year that would not have otherwise been accepted by the Agency. While this required increase of service places an impossible burden on the present staff, the decision is viewed by the Agency as a necessary step in maintaining the high standards of justice in this state.

The total caseload for the year 1971 in all offices of the agency was 2,448. This includes 1,913 adult criminal cases, 491 juvenile cases, and 44 sanity cases.


The Public Defender Agency is working closely with interested groups and individuals regarding the broader problems of causes of criminal conduct, means of reducing crime, and development of effective programs for rehabilitation. Attorneys from the staff have been called upon to address school classes and civic groups. Drug prevention programs have received a high priority for participation by staff attorneys.

A significant development in the area of rehabilitation occurred during the year when a federal grant was awarded to the Agency for an Offender Rehabilitation Program. This is a pilot program utilizing one experienced rehabilitation counselor in the Anchorage Office. His duties include the development of educational or work plans for clients who demonstrate potential but have lacked direction and purpose in their lives. The counselor is aware of the various rehabilitation and training programs provided by government agencies and private organizations and has contacts with employers willing to offer work opportunities to clients. Clients with little or no motivation and those who will predictably succeed without supervision are not assisted by this pilot program. The program does not duplicate services presently provided by our probation system. The tremendous overload of cases has reduced probation to a mere reporting service in Alaska. It does not operate until the defendant is adjudicated guilty. The pilot program operates on the theory that the client puts a great deal of confidence in his attorney while under the pressure of pending criminal charges. This can lead to a period of greater motivation and is seen as an optimum time for re-directing behavioral patterns.

The statute creating the Public Defender Agency does not attempt to prescribe exact standards of indigency. The policy of the Agency is to carefully evaluate each applicant for service to determine whether or not he can afford a private attorney. Many clients are directed away from the Agency to private counsel. All clients are billed at the conclusion of their cases. Voluntary payments of \$1,723.32 were paid in response to Agency billing in 1971. All bills are turned over to the Attorney General for collection as directed by statute. Procedures are now being implemented between that office and ours to facilitate collection.

This annual report is presented by the Alaska Public Defender Agency as required by AS 18.85.160(b). The Public Defender Agency provides legal representation for indigent defendants who are formally charged with the commission of crimes. That representation includes court appearances, pre-trial investigation and preparation; extradition hearings, violation of probation hearings, sanity hearings, and post-conviction relief hearings. Additionally, convicted indigent defendants and juvenile offenders are represented on appeal to the Supreme Court of Alaska; and, in some instances, they are represented on appeal to the United States Supreme Court.

The Agency is administered by the Alaska State Public Defender, nominated by the Judicial Council and appointed by the Governor, with legislative confirmation, for a term of four years. Structurally, the office is composed of a headquarters at Anchorage and four regional offices.

The attached statistics, required by statute, indicate an increase of 566 cases in the calendar year 1971 over the previous calendar year. During the year 1971, the Agency represented 461 more adults than the previous year, and juvenile cases increased by 101. A much greater increase will undoubtedly follow in the year 1972 because of the recent Supreme Court decision in Alexander v. Anchorage. In that case, the Supreme Court of Alaska ruled that indigent defendants charged with misdemeanors, carrying penalties that could result in imprisonment, high fines, or loss of valuable license, are entitled to court-appointed counsel. Following the decision of November 19, 1971, in Anchorage alone, 219 cases were added to the Agency caseload for the balance of the year that would not have otherwise been accepted by the Agency. While this required increase of service places an impossible burden on the present staff, the decision is viewed by the Agency as a necessary step in maintaining the high standards of justice in this state.

The total caseload for the year 1971 in all offices of the agency was 2,448. This includes 1,913 adult criminal cases, 491 juvenile cases, and 44 sanity cases.


The Public Defender Agency is working closely with interested groups and individuals regarding the broader problems of causes of criminal conduct, means of reducing crime, and development of effective programs for rehabilitation. Attorneys from the staff have been called upon to address school classes and civic groups. Drug prevention programs have received a high priority for participation by staff attorneys.

A significant development in the area of rehabilitation occurred during the year when a federal grant was awarded to the Agency for an Offender Rehabilitation Program. This is a pilot program utilizing one experienced rehabilitation counselor in the Anchorage Office. His duties include the development of educational or work plans for clients who demonstrate potential but have lacked direction and purpose in their lives. The counselor is aware of the various rehabilitation and training programs provided by government agencies and private organizations and has contacts with employers willing to offer work opportunities to clients. Clients with little or no motivation and those who will predictably succeed without supervision are not assisted by this pilot program. The program does not duplicate services presently provided by our probation system. The tremendous overload of cases has reduced probation to a mere reporting service in Alaska. It does not operate until the defendant is adjudicated guilty.
