

\* Section 1. The sum of \$413,000 is appropriated from the general fund  
to the scholarship revolving loan fund established under AS 14.40.751, for  
the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972.

\* Sec. 2. The sum of \$35,000 is appropriated from the general fund to  
the Department of Education, planning and research, to cover unfunded  
operating costs of administering the scholarship loan program for the fiscal  
year ending June 30, 1972.

\* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.

HOUSE BILLS NO. 535 & 536

The Committee has been concerned with the availability of funds for students wishing to continue their education. Last session the Finance Committee introduced a bill substantially expanding the State's Scholarship Loan Program. The Committee also included \$2.5 million in its version of the appropriation bill to fund the new program. (The Free Conference Committee subsequently reduced this figure to \$1.5 million.)



During the interim the Budget and Audit Committee followed closely the activity of the new Scholarship Loan Program. It was apparent several months ago that the demand for student loans would exceed the \$1.5 million appropriated. In response to the combined interests of the House of Representatives, the Budget and Audit Committee, and the Committee on Finance, we have introduced this supplemental appropriation to fully fund the Scholarship Loan Program for the current fiscal year. In addition the bill provides funding to cover the administrative costs of the program, costs that were not included in last year's appropriation.

The Committee has introduced a companion bill to repeal provisions for forgiveness of scholarship loans. One of the reasons given in support of scholarship grants--the forgiven portion would encourage students to remain and work in Alaska--did not appear to have real merit. In addition, certain difficulties are associated with loan forgiveness as structured: namely (1) the administrative burden of determining residency and the appropriate amount of forgiveness for former students scattered over the country was described by administration officials as an "administrative nightmare"; and (2) the possibility exists for misuse of program funds through the furnishing of no interest/low interest loans to high income parents. On the positive side the Committee believes that full funding of statewide student needs cannot practically be achieved in the legislature unless the funding is restricted to coverage of student loans.

INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS FOR AN  
ALASKA CAREER AND HIGHER EDUCATION  
SCHOLARSHIP LOAN

**ELIGIBILITY OF STUDENTS**

A student may apply for a scholarship loan if

- (1) he is a resident of Alaska who has been domiciled in Alaska (and who has resided in Alaska) for at least two years before making an application for a student loan; and if
- (2) he is either
  - (a) enrolled or accepted for enrollment as a full-time student in a career education or associate or baccalaureate or graduate degree program, or
  - (b) a graduate of a high school, or scheduled for graduation from a high school within six months with sufficient credits to be admitted to a career education program or to an accredited college or university.

**SELECTION CRITERIA**

In selecting from among the eligible students, those students who will be awarded loans, the following items will be taken into consideration.

- (1) the student's financial need
- (2) entering freshmen who are graduates of Alaska high schools or who are graduates of a high school outside the state if their Alaskan residency has been continuous
- (3) personal recommendations from the student's instructors, employers, and others familiar with his abilities
- (4) the student's record of achievement.

**CONDITIONS OF LOANS**

1. Undergraduate loans shall not exceed \$2,500 for any one school year.
2. Graduate loans shall not exceed \$5,000 for any one school year.
3. Scholarship loans may be used only for tuition and required fees, books, and room and board.
4. Scholarship loans may not be made to any student for more than six years.
5. Loans may only be used to attend a
  - (a) career education program in vocational-technical training approved by the Alaska Department of Education, or a
  - (b) college or university accredited by the accrediting association for the region in which the college or university is located.
6. A student must be enrolled full-time which means at least 12 semester hours of credit during the semester at a college or university or the equivalent in clock hours (30 hours per week) in a career education program and to maintain eligibility he must continue to be enrolled as a full-time student in good standing.
7. Payments to students will be made on the normal pattern of payments of the school attended, unless otherwise determined.
8. Loans are granted for the school year which is defined in the law as September 1 through August 31.
9. The student loan program shall be carried out without regard to the race, creed, sex, color, ancestry, national origin, or membership in fraternal or political organizations of the student applying for the loan.

## CONDITIONS OF REPAYMENT

1. Loans shall be noninterest bearing while the student is enrolled full time in good standing or is fulfilling required military services.
2. Interest on the loan shall be at the rate of five (5) percent.
3. Repayment of a loan shall commence within one (1) year after a student terminates his studies or required military service. The loan shall be fully repaid within a period of six (6) years. In cases of hardship the student may request an extension not to exceed an additional five (5) years.
4. A portion of the loan may be considered a grant if, upon *completion* of the course of study for which the loan was granted, the grantee spends at least two (2) years employed in the state. The portion of the loan regarded as a grant shall be the following percentages of the total loan received plus accrued interest:

(a) more than 2 but less than 3 years residency	10%
(b) more than 3 but less than 4 years residency	20%
(c) more than 4 but less than 5 years residency	30%
(d) over 5 years residency	40%
5. Security is not required for the loan, but the law does provide for payment of costs of collecting delinquent loans. It also provides that if a loan is in default accelerated repayments may be required.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### 1. *RESIDENCY:*

The law is quite specific on Alaskan residency in that it refers both to domicile and residence. Generally absence to attend school or required military service does not break residence. However, minor children whose parents or guardian move may lose residence. Applicants who claim residence independent of parents must document their claim. The claim of residence is subject to both pre and post audit.

### 2. *NEED:*

Basically financial need is established by the applicant's statements of "College Expenses" and "Sources of Funds to Meet College Expenses" on the loan application form. Sometime before the applicant's school year begins the School Loan Officer or comparable school official will be requested to verify the college expenses for that particular school as stated by the applicant.

In the event that demand exceeds the available funds it may be necessary to further evaluate applications in light of total financial resources available to the applicant. In this event a confidential financial needs statement may be required.

### 3. *RECOMMENDATION:*

Personal recommendations from the student's instructors, employers, and others familiar with the student's abilities will be considered in selecting loan grantees. It is the responsibility of the applicant to have these sent to the Department of Education. The Department will check with the Student Loan Officer at the institution to be attended and in the case of entering freshmen with the high school from which graduated. Other references are the responsibility of the applicant.

### 4. *APPLICATION FORMS:*

In completing the college expense column on application form number 65-011-04 please note that this is annual expenses. If you are applying for a loan for a lesser period please cross-out "*annual*" and write in the period involved. In analyzing college expenses the loan officers will be concerned that the expenses are reasonable and necessary.

5. All sources of funds must be listed. The law stipulates the maximum amount of loan and for what purposes it may be spent (only tuition and required fees, books, and board and room). Requests that exceed the maximum or propose to spend for other purposes than statutes permit cannot be considered. Financial statements are also subject to pre and post audit.
6. Any change in address, residency, school attended, expenses or income must be *reported* promptly to the Department of Education.
7. Applications complete with supporting documents received prior to August 1, 1971 will receive priority in consideration for loans.

9. Applicants who filed under the prior law for 1971-72 loans will not have to re-submit applications unless there is a change in their request.
