In response to your inquiry this date for a fiscal breakdown of HB 520 which requests a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$65,032, the following information is pertinent:

The first legislative supplemental which was passed earlier this session funded legislators' per diem and the temporary employees through May 23. HB 520, in its present form, funds both through May 31 - a period of eight days.

Per Diem - 8 days at \$2,100 per day	\$ 16,800
Temp. Employees - 8 days at \$6,029 per day	48,232
	<u>\$ 65,032</u>

However, since we have already gone two days past the 31st, HB 520 must be amended upward if the legislators are to receive their per diem and the employees their pay. Assuming we may be in session another day or two, another five days or so funding is needed. Five additional days would require the sum of \$40,645.

In addition to that, it is requested that \$5,000 be inserted to pay the initial fees connected with the retention of legal counsel to handle the Warwick suit as directed by SCR 36.

These additions make the total supplemental \$110,677. Any monies not expended by reason of adjournment of the legislature prior to Wednesday, the 4th, would be lapsed.

The Sponsor Substitute for House Bill 526 removes the major objection which we had to the original bill. As re-drafted, this bill would allow an employee to file a W-4E with his employer if he will not earn in excess of \$100 a month or \$1,200 a year.

Our only objection to this legislation which remains is a philosophical one. There is an extremely small number of individuals in the State, mainly students, who will be able to take advantage of this provision. This then amounts to specialized legislation for a very limited minority of the tax paying public. Further, we feel it is an excellent educational process for students to realize that when they become employed and earn wages, certain responsibilities follow thereafter, one of which is preparing and filing an income tax return.

Further, we feel it is an excellent educational process for students to realize that when they become employed and earn wages, certain responsibilities follow thereafter, one of which is preparing and filing an income tax return.

The Sponsor Substitute for House Bill 526 removes the major objection which we had to the original bill. As re-drafted, this bill would allow an employee to file a W-4E with his employer if he will not earn in excess of \$100 a month or \$1,200 a year.

Our only objection to this legislation which remains is a philosophical one. There is an extremely small number of individuals in the State, mainly students, who will be able to take advantage of this provision. This then amounts to specialized legislation for a very limited minority of the tax paying public. Further, we feel it is an excellent educational process for students to realize that when they become employed and earn wages, certain responsibilities follow thereafter, one of which is preparing and filing an income tax return.
