

Legislative Affairs Drafting was not able to make changes to the 5/10/82 version of SCS CSHB 643 (Finance) because unless there are originally alternative versions written, only the latest version is kept. It is very rarely necessary to return to a previous version, so later versions are merely re-recorded on the mag-card used for that bill. This is the mechanical procedure Legislative Affairs Drafting always uses.

The draft for SCS CSHB 643 (Finance), dated 5/10/82 and distributed to the Senate Finance Committee members at the 5/13/82 meeting, has since been replaced by a draft dated 5/13/82. I'd like to bring to your attention 5 sections of CSHB643 that have broad policy and fiscal impacts that should be reviewed before Senate Finance moves this bill.

Sec. 109 Appropriates \$325,000 to Kuspuk REAA for White Alice Vocational Program.

This type of appropriation sets a bad precedent by circumventing the normal funding process in the Foundation Formula. School districts in other areas develop their vocational programs from funding generated by the foundation program. This direct appropriation sidesteps a process set in place by statute, in addition to obligating the state to pick up the costs for a program not self-generating year after year.

Sec. 111 Appropriates \$16,000 for postsecondary needs assessment in Yukon Flats REAA.

If a postsecondary needs assessment is really to determine the viability of a vocational program, then many of the arguments regarding the White Alice Vocational Program apply.

Sec. 186 Appropriates \$1,166,000 to Kotzebue Technical Center.

There appears \$1,090,000 in the DOE operating budget; if this appropriation goes through it would appear to be appropriate that we question whether to delete the corresponding amount in the operating budget.

As with the White Alice site, this vocational education program has been set up outside of the Foundation Formula system.

Sec. 198/199.

198 Appropriates \$634,000 to Northwest Arctic REAA for a bilingual materials center.

199 Appropriates \$415,300 to City of Kotzebue for Northwest Arctic REAA for ITV.

These two direct appropriations set up special funding methods for items that can be taken care of through the operating budget.

I think it's apparent that we have cut the Foundation program -- which provides State aid to all schools -- to fund items that have no corresponding State policy or statutory basis, i.e. vocational programs such as White Alice -- that could not, without additional appropriations year after year, be self-sustaining.

My other concerns rest with direct appropriations made to municipalities for school construction. The State picks up 80% of the cost of school construction, and I think it is important to be aware that the funds the municipalities receive may all be co-mingled and not easily identifiable -- and because of this, the possibility arises that the State may reimburse municipalities for items for which funds were directly appropriated.


Dear Senator Dankworth:

A review of SCS CSHB-643 (Finance) has identified what could be a serious breach of the state's responsibility in fulfilling its obligations in meeting the requirements of the Tobeluk (Molly Hootch) Consent Decree.

I specifically invite your attention to sections 156, 157 and 163. Diomedes is the last remaining Tobeluk site where action has not been taken to secure a secondary facility. Should the legislation be enacted, all funds for the Diomedes secondary school will be withdrawn and the state could be back in expensive and time consuming litigation for not doing what it has already agreed to do.

I respectfully request that the present provisions of Sections 156, 157 and 163 be dropped entirely from consideration in this or any other bill before your committee.


