Please revise H.B.295 to include a net zero (delete/add) supplemental to reappropriate \$299,400 from the FY 81 appropriation for Administration Component, Maintenance & Operations BRU (Chapter 120/SLA 1980, page 55, line 10) to the capital appropriation for rural airport weather reporting (Chapter 50/SLA 1980, page 86, line 10). DOTPF received \$300,000 in Chapter 50 for rural airport weather reporting equipment. This amount assumed installation of equipment at 50 sites at a cost of \$5,000 each. The cost is now estimated at \$9,510 each, for a total of \$570,600. In Chapter 120, DOTPF received \$329,400 for the weather reporting function (basically operations and maintenance). DOTPF has utilized \$30,000 of this amount for a consultant contract to recommend a plan for implementation of this function and proposes to use the remaining funds for installation. The FY 82 budget treats the \$329,400 as a continuation item, assuring the availability of funds for operations and maintenance after installation.



Attached you will find the latest work draft of HCS CSSB 321 (Fin).

While drafting the bill, an additional question came to mind. Section 26 of the bill adds sec. 56 to Chapter 120, SLA 1980. Subsection (d) of that section seems odd to me since it has the effect of lapsing "federal receipts" into the general fund. Can we do that?

For your information, I personally think the reappropriation method used in the new Sec. 29 is vastly better than the amendments of individual line items found throughout the rest of this bill. Both methods are probably legally acceptable. One is much neater and more comprehensible than the other.



This bill was brought to me for drafting at about 2 P.M. Wednesday with a 5 P.M. deadline. Because of the rush, I did not have time to carefully review the draft submitted by your staff (the time available was needed for typing, proofing and other processing).

However, I did want to note some problems for your consideration. Sec. 15(b) refers to "Alaska Energy Center . . . projects under AS 37.25.030". There are no such projects under AS 37.25.030. That section refers only to the fact that appropriations for such projects do not lapse. Sec. 15(b) is misleading.

I also question Sec. 16(c) and (d). I think that under AS 37.05.315 grants to recipients other than municipalities need to be made through a state department (probably Community and Regional Affairs).

Also I cannot identify the material in Sec. 20(a). I do not find it at p. 16, line 9 of Chapter 120, SLA 1980. And in addition, more than one line is apparently amended although only one line is mentioned.

I also think that your Sec. 22 should refer only to Sec. 21(a).

In your Sec. 8(a) the order of the appropriations listed does not match the order of the lines to be amended. The section is all out of order and quite confusing.

I do not understand how they can come up with the portions of appropriations set out in 56(d) and 56(e) in Sec. 26 of this bill. I cannot figure out what is meant by these lapse dates.

In addition, I had some trouble with the title to the bill. Even though I am told that the appropriations made in this bill are offset by appropriation transfers, this bill actually makes appropriations. That fact is not encompassed in the title submitted to me (compare title to Chapter 173, SLA 1980). Likewise, the special lapse dates in the Governor's bill are not in the title. I was unsure as to whether you expected us to attempt to rewrite the title as submitted.

Please revise H.B.295 to include a net zero (delete/add) supplemental to reappropriate \$299,400 from the FY 81 appropriation for Administration Component, Maintenance & Operations BRU (Chapter 120/SLA 1980, page 55, line 10) to the capital appropriation for rural airport weather reporting (Chapter 50/SLA 1980, page 86, line 10). DOTPF received \$300,000 in Chapter 50 for rural airport weather reporting equipment. This amount assumed installation of equipment at 50 sites at a cost of \$5,000 each. The cost is now estimated at \$9,510 each, for a total of \$570,600. In Chapter 120, DOTPF received \$329,400 for the weather reporting function (basically operations and maintenance). DOTPF has utilized \$30,000 of this amount for a consultant contract to recommend a plan for implementation of this function and proposes to use the remaining funds for installation. The FY 82 budget treats the \$329,400 as a continuation item, assuring the availability of funds for operations and maintenance after installation.






