- Sec. 73, page 12 The appropriation of \$900,000 is reduced to a new figure of \$650,000
- Sec. 160, page 31 New section replacing former Sec. 160. Reduces SB-162 (1983) appropriation to Department of Environmental Conservation for sewer line extension in Bethel by half, \$200,000. The additional \$200,000 is reappropriated as a grant to Bethel in new Section 230. The Administration requested this change to conform to 50-50 match for DEC water and sewer projects.
- ✓ Sec. 179, page 35 Adds subsection (b) following 4 (a) to those appropriations which will lapse June 30, 1984. This is a technical change which will permit the unincorporated community grants (\$1,000 per capita program established in 1981) to continue through FY 84, for those communities that have yet to receive their entitlements.
- Sec. 189, page 37 Adds new sections 211, 214, 215, 223, 225, and 227, to the list of projects in the bill that are capital projects subject to AS 37.25.020 (do not lapse clause)
- Sec. 190, page 37 Adds: new sections 213, 218, 219, 229, 230, and 234 to the list of appropriations to be disbursed in accordance with AS 37.05.315 - AS 37.05.319 (Municipal, designated, and unincorporated grants procedures)
- Sec. 210, page 41 Reduces the \$38 million appropriation made earlier this session for the Union-Marathon oil royalty settlement by \$1,000,000. The Department of Law has paid the companies in full and has reported an excess of funds.
- Sec. 211, page 41 Appropriates \$1 million to the Department of Commerce for a 50-50 matching grant program with the Alaska Repertory Theatre, through the office of the Commissioner.
- Sec. 212, page 41 Amends the purpose of 1981 appropriation for student housing in Juneau to permit the remaining funds to be used for building and equipment purchase.
- Sec. 213, page 41 New Section: Bethel \$426,000 for a waste heat utilidor to public facilities.
