## STATEMENT OF INTENT

There is a recognized state government role for support of arts projects and groups in general, and professional, regional theatre serving Alaska in particular.

However, one purpose of state assistance, where appropriate, should be to act as a stimulus or catalyst for support from the private sector.

It is the intention of the \$1,000,000 appropriation, which will be administered by the Department of Commerce and Economic Development, Office of the Commissioner, to establish a pilot challenge grant program to encourage greater private sector participation and involvement with the Alaska Repertory Theatre. The Theatre will be enabled to seek financial support from the business community, foundations, endowments, individuals and other sources of non-state revenue, exclusive of or in addition to box office income. For every dollar raised in this manner, the State challenge grant in an equivalent amount will be available, subject to the limitations of the appropriation.

The appropriation lapses to the extent not utilized during the fiscal year. It is intended that the Theatre will provide the Department with records providing satisfactory evidence that private sector donations entitle the Theatre to receive funds from this appropriation on a dollar-for-dollar basis. Nothing in this appropriation shall be deemed to affect the Theatre's eligibility under other programs.
