Dear Mr. President:

Under the authority of art. III, sec. 18, of the Alaska Constitution, I am transmitting a bill making supplemental and special appropriations for capital projects.

The intent of all of the appropriations in this bill is to put out to bid well-defined capital projects that are ready for construction in the 1983 construction season.

My selection of projects was made from nominations by communities from across the state, by state agencies, and by some legislators. The top priority in consideration of projects which are ready for construction was to meet immediate life and health safety needs. In this category you will find many water and sewer projects and school repairs.

Economic development projects are a high priority in this bill. You will find dock and harbor and other projects, to create the infrastructure for economic development throughout the state.

Another priority is the upgrading of highways. I am proposing to spend many millions of dollars in making our highway system usable by the heavier commercial and tourist traffic which our economic development projects will help bring about. In particular, there are several projects to improve highways in the interior region and Anchorage that will benefit most of the people in the state.

Another major consideration in project selection is to direct some construction employment in 1983 toward regions in which employment has become soft or is in decline.

The bill totals nearly \$250 million. This is the maximum amount we can allow for a FY '83 supplemental capital appropriation. This judgment is based on our long-term financial forecasts and the likely near-term availability of fund balances to finance state government.


There is a \$15 million appropriation in this bill intended to fund small rural construction projects. It is my intention that money will be allocated from this fund on mutual agreement between my office and each legislator who has projects that qualify for this fund.

I expect that the projects identified in this bill will now be subjected to close public scrutiny. This administration stands ready to testify and explain them at any time during the forthcoming public hearings on this bill.

In summary, this bill represents my best judgment as to how we should spend the money available to us for capital projects in fiscal year 1983. I welcome your suggestions for better projects, and will be pleased to substitute any higher priority projects that will meet or exceed the objectives that have been established.

I urge early consideration and enactment of this bill so that the state will be able to take full advantage of the 1983 construction season.
