II, sec. 15, of the Alaska Constitution, I am striking the appropriations on page 11, line 12 (\$1,100,000 for Anchorage Community College "lease or lease/purchase administrative") and page 20, line 24 (\$5,600,000 for Anchorage "port expansion"), and am reducing the appropriation on page 12, line 10 (Anchorage-Steller "phase II/other school projects," reduced from \$5,158,000 to \$3,558,000). This veto action is based on my belief that these items are of a lower priority for this FY 83 capital budget.

Page 6, line 10

It is the intent of the House Finance Committee that a special appropriation be made for the cities of Newhalen and Nondalton for road construction between Illiamna and Nondalton as a special grant to the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities.

The House Transportation Committee requests the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to work cooperatively with the cities of Newhalen and Nondalton and to manage and administer this project pursuant to AS 35.14.080.

It is the House Finance Committee's intent that the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities will work cooperatively with these communities to ensure this project is completed on the existing timeframe and will not be delayed.

Page 12, line 6

The lease or lease-purchase of all or part of an office building for the Anchorage Community College to be used as its administrative headquarters and faculty office building with the intent that they give up one square foot of existing office space to UAA for every two square feet they acquire.

Page 14, line 7

These books are explicitly and exclusively for that section of the library which would otherwise be used for an auditorium or small theatre. The funds are to immediately lapse if library design is altered to accommodate such an auditorium or small theatre.

Page 27, lines 20-21

The intent of these funds is to encourage the paving of the heretofore unpaved subdivision streets in House District 10 which the Municipality accepted prior to the current paving requirement and so must periodically grade at great annual expense. These funds and all interest earned on them are to be exclusively used to provide matching funds to help pay for the paving of such older unpaved streets and are to lapse immediately if the interest earned on them is not totally add-
