The purpose of this appropriation Act is to commit the expenditure of approximately \$75 million from the state general fund to a series of projects selected to put Alaskans throughout the state to work. The projects in the bill were selected to provide a worthwhile public purpose, provide immediate employment, be labor intensive, and ensure to the maximum extent possible the use of Alaskan contractors or vendors.

In the expenditure of the money appropriated by CS HB 512 (Finance), it is the intent of the Legislature that, when feasible, projects be subject to competitive bid. In determining feasibility, fund recipients should consider the size and scope of the project, whether local hire is reasonably assured, whether the bidding process will result in an unreasonable delay in the project getting underway, and the needs and interests of the local community.


For those projects that are competitively bid, the Legislature intends that the award of funds be guided by the State Administrative Manual, with emphasis on the following:

1. Separate solicitation for goods or services to accommodate Alaskan vendors if they would otherwise not be able to respond.
2. Solicitation of quotations from Alaskan vendors to make small purchases.
3. Use of products grown and manufactured in Alaska including wood products, food, precast concrete, and other materials.
4. Award of a least 10% of evaluation points for proposals for services to qualified Alaskan vendors.

The Legislature further intends that municipal, school, and named recipients of grants use a portion of funds received to employ youth when it is practical and appropriate. Funds appropriated to the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities are to be transferred to local communities through Transfer of Responsibility Agreements (TORAs) whenever feasible.

It is the intent of the Legislature that the appropriations made in CS HB 512 (Finance) be spent during the 1988

construction season. The bill provides for a lapse date of October 30, 1989 to allow for the completion of those few projects for which construction may extend into the 1989 construction season. The Legislature intends that unexpended and unobligated funds lapse into the general fund as specified in the bill, and not be subject to reappropriation.

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LETTER OF INTENT

HB 512

An Act making special appropriations for projects to boost the Alaskan economy.

The purpose of this appropriation Act is to commit the expenditure of approximately \$75 million from the state general fund to a series of projects selected to put Alaskans throughout the state to work. The projects in the bill were selected to provide a worthwhile public purpose, provide immediate employment, be labor intensive, and ensure to the maximum extent possible the use of Alaskan contractors or vendors.

In the expenditure of the money appropriated by HB 512, it is the intent of the Legislature that, when feasible, projects be subject to competitive bid. In determining feasibility, fund recipients should consider the size and scope of the project, whether local hire is reasonably assured, whether the bidding process will result in an unreasonable delay in the project getting underway, and the needs and interests of the local community.

For those projects that are competitively bid, the Legislature intends that the award of funds be guided by the State Administrative Manual, with emphasis on the following:

1. Separate solicitation for goods or services to accommodate Alaskan vendors if they would otherwise not be able to respond.
2. Solicitation of quotations from Alaskan vendors to make small purchases.
3. Use of products grown and manufactured in Alaska including wood products, food, precast concrete, and other materials.
4. Award of at least 10% of evaluation points for proposals for services to qualified Alaskan vendors.

The Legislature further intends that municipal, school, and named recipients of grants use a portion of funds received to employ youth when it is practical and appropriate. Funds appropriated to the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities are to be transferred to local communities through Transfer of Responsibility Agreements (TORAs) whenever feasible.

It is the intent of the Legislature that the appropriations made in HB 512 be spent during the 1988 construction season. The bill provides for a lapse date of October 30, 1989 to allow for the completion of those few projects for which construction may extend into the 1989 construction season. The Legislature intends that unexpended and unobligated funds lapse into the general fund as specified in the bill, and not be subject to reappropriation.
