ANALYSIS CONTINUATION:

This bill amends provisions of ch. 66, SLA 1991, mental health trust settlement, that the superior court rejected and amends other provisions that the parties have found to be unworkable or unenforceable. The bill seeks to resolve the Weiss lawsuit by reconstituting the trust legislatively, establishing a Mental Health Trust Authority, and providing for annual cash payments to the Trust for fifteen years.

Between July 1, 1994 and December 31, 1994, the plaintiffs will be required to expend some effort to obtain dismissal of the litigation if this legislation is enacted as a compromise settlement. Because Weiss is a class action, the court will approve a settlement by following several steps. The court must first preliminarily approve the settlement after finding that it is within a range that is fair, reasonable, and adequate to the beneficiaries, considering the risks and uncertainties of continued litigation. After the court grants preliminary approval, notice of the proposed settlement will be given to the class, written comments will be received (which should take at least 90 days), and the court will hold a "fairness" hearing at which time the court will hear from all interested parties that desire to comment on the proposed settlement. Following that hearing, the court will determine whether to grant final approval of the proposed settlement and dismiss the Weiss case. We estimate that \$200,000 will be necessary for plaintiffs to participate in this mandatory process.

Dear Representative Larson:

Jay Hogan of your staff suggested that we prepare a section-by-section analysis of CSHB 201 (FIN), and identify which sections take effect immediately, which take effect only if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994, and which that take effect immediately will be repealed if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Section 1 contains legislative findings and purposes that strengthen the state's legal position. In doing so, that will make it more likely that the court will dismiss the case by December 15, 1994. That outcome, of course, will benefit the beneficiaries of the mental health trust, third party purchasers of former mental health land (the "moms and pops"), municipalities that have been conveyed former mental health land, the development community, and the environmental, fishing, and tourism industry intervenors. Section 1 takes effect immediately and does not get repealed even if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Sections 2 and 45 extend the time for municipal selections for two years for those municipalities that have agreed to convey land to the state for designation as trust land (Anchorage, Mat-Su Borough, and Ketchikan Gateway Borough). They take effect immediately and do not get repealed even if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Section 3 is an "incentive" for early dismissal of the lawsuit. It amends provisions of ch. 66, SLA 1991, that in turn amend the permanent fund statutes to provide for the Alaska Permanent Fund Corporation to manage the monetary corpus of the mental health trust. It takes effect only if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Sections 4, 5, and 6 are "incentives" for early dismissal that amend chapter 66 provisions regarding the governor's responsibility to consider the recommendations of the trust authority as to state general funds to pay for the state's mental

health program. They take effect only if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Section 7 is an "incentive" for early dismissal that amends chapter 66 provisions regarding the legislature's responsibility to consider the recommendations of the trust authority as to state general funds to pay for the state's mental health program. It takes effect only if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Sections 8 and 9 are "incentives" for early dismissal that amend chapter 66 provisions relating to the trust authority's powers, duties, and responsibilities to provide that (1) the authority is the trustee of the mental health trust, (2) it has a fiduciary obligation to ensure that the assets are managed consistent with the state's obligations under the federal Enabling Act, (3) it must contract with the Alaska Permanent Fund Corporation for management of the monetary corpus of the trust and with the Department of Natural Resources for management of mental health trust land, and (4) the contract with DNR must include certain provisions to protect the interests of the beneficiaries. They take effect only if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Sections 10 and 11 establish a new mental health trust income and proceeds account and provide for its utilization. The idea is that money will go into the account from both sales and leases of mental health land and, as required by the federal Enabling Act, first be spent for mental health programs (in a manner identical to the current treatment of the six percent allocation under ch. 210, SLA 1990). They take effect immediately, but get repealed and effectively replaced by the mental health trust fund and the mental health trust income account (see next paragraph) if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994, and the "incentive" provisions for early dismissal take effect.

Sections 12, 13, 14, 15, and 16 are "incentives" for early dismissal that amend provisions of chapter 66 establishing the mental health trust fund and the mental health trust income account. The trust fund is the cash principal of the trust, consisting of the \$200 million up-front appropriation and monetary land proceeds that, under Title 13 trust statutes, are considered part of the corpus of the trust (e.g., land sale proceeds; a portion of oil and gas and coal royalty receipts, if any; etc.) to be preserved in perpetuity. The income account consists of earnings on the trust fund and monetary land proceeds not considered part of the corpus that will be used annually by the trust authority to fund part of the state's mental health program. The sections take effect only if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Section 17 provides for the Department of Natural Resources to manage mental health trust land. It takes effect immediately and does not get repealed even if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Sections 18 and 22 provide that the Department of Natural Resources must establish a separate unit to manage mental health trust land, the employees of which will be in the partially-exempt service. They take effect immediately and do not get repealed even if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Sections 19 and 20 are "incentives" for early dismissal that conform the Older Alaskans Commission's statutory responsibilities with changes made by other "incentive" provisions in chapter 66. They take effect only if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Section 21 is an "incentive" for early dismissal that gives the advisory board on alcoholism and drug abuse the responsibility to plan for services for chronic alcoholics with psychosis, one of the beneficiary groups. It takes effect only if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Sections 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, and 29 are "incentives" for early dismissal that amend provisions of chapter 66 relating to the trust authority's and other agencies' powers and duties with respect to the use of money from the income account. They take effect only if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Sections 30, 31, and 32 are "incentives" for early dismissal that, under the legislative purposes of the Community Mental Health Services Act, would give consumers and family members as well as representatives within mental health planning regions to participate in planning for mental health services at the local level, require the department to consult with the mental health board in adopting regulations and establishing priorities, and add a definition inadvertently dropped in one of the chapter 66 provisions that will go into effect if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994. These sections take effect only if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Section 33 is an "incentive" for early dismissal that conforms the Department of Health and Social Services' responsibility for preparing the state's mental health program with the provisions of chapter 66. It takes effect only if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Section 34 is an "incentive" for early dismissal that reduces the size of the mental health board from the current 18 to 24 members to 12 to 16 members. It takes effect only if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Section 35 is an "incentive" for early dismissal that removes from the mental health board the planning responsibility for the Alzheimer's disease and related dementia beneficiary group. It takes effect only if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Section 36 is not truly an "incentive," but is necessary to amend a provision of chapter 66 that otherwise would redirect to the trust funds that should reimburse the general fund for general funds spent on the state's mental health program under this new approach. Because it is only needed if chapter 66 goes into effect, it takes effect only if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Section 37 amends the effective date provision of chapter 66 to provide that it only takes effect upon dismissal of the lawsuit with no appeal having been taken by December 15, 1994. It takes effect immediately.

Section 38 provides that, if chapter 66 takes effect, it takes effect on December 16, 1994.

Section 39 repeals certain statutes that must be repealed whether the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994, or not. It takes effect immediately.

Section 40 provides for the return of some original mental health land to the trust and the redesignation of some other state land as mental health trust land. It also provides that -- unless taken care of by the set-off -- the compensation to the trust under the bill first compensates the trust for land conveyed to third parties, second for land conveyed to municipalities, and third for land in parks and wildlife refuges and used by state agencies. It takes effect immediately and does not get repealed even if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Section 41 confirms and ratifies the 1978 legislative removal from trust status of all original mental health land that will not be returned to the trust under the bill, removes from the trust any additional land received by the state under the Enabling Act not already removed from trust status under the 1973 legislation, and ratifies and confirms all actions the state has taken with respect the land removed from trust status. It takes effect immediately and does not get repealed even if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Section 42 establishes that state mental health expenditures to be set-off against state monetary liability to the trust for land not returned to trust status, as authorized by the Alaska Supreme Court in the Weiss decision, is \$1.32 billion. It takes effect immediately and does not get repealed even if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Section 43 is an "incentive" for early dismissal that provides for an orderly transition to trust authority coordination of the state's mental health program. It is drawn from a similar provision in chapter 66. It takes effect only if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Section 44 provides that up to \$100 million per year is allocated to the income and proceeds account (section 10) for as long as it takes to satisfy any additional state monetary liability to the trust after the land and the set-off are taken into account. Any money allocated to the account under this provision would then be available for legislative appropriation first for mental health programs and then for any other public purpose -- i.e., just as the six percent of the unrestricted general fund allocated to the mental health trust income account under current law is treated -- as authorized by the federal Enabling Act. It takes effect immediately, but gets repealed (because it would be unnecessary) if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Section 46 is an "incentive" for early dismissal that provides for an orderly reduction of the mental health board. It takes effect only if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994.

Section 47 provides that, if the case is not dismissed by December 15, 1994, chapter 66 is repealed and the "incentive" provisions of this bill do not take effect.

Section 48 provides that, if the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994, sections 10, 11, and 44 of the bill are repealed (along with a statute that currently provides priorities for mental health services that will be superseded by the priorities in the chapter 66 "incentives" that will go into effect).

Section 49 provides that the "incentives" go into effect on December 16, 1994, if the condition for their going into effect -- the case is dismissed by December 15, 1994 -- is satisfied.

Section 50 provides that sections 38 and 39 providing for the two possible contingencies -- (1) that the case is not dismissed by December 15, 1994, in which case the "incentives" are repealed, or (2) that the case is dismissed by then, in which case they go into effect -- take effect on December 16, 1994.

Section 51 provides that sections 1, 2, 10, 11, 17, 18, 22, 31, 32, 37-42, 44, and 45 take effect immediately.

We appreciate that this is all somewhat confusing, especially the contingent effective dates with some things taking effect now and remaining in effect, some taking effect now but subject to subsequent repeal if the case is dismissed, and some taking effect only if the case is truly over by December 15, 1994.



We believe this approach is absolutely essential, however, to ensure that all of the parties other than the mental health community -- i.e., the third party purchasers, municipalities, development interests, environmental community, and the state -- can be assured of early dismissal in return for the "incentive" package offered. If the bill becomes law, it then remains only for the mental health community to accept the "incentive" package by agreeing to early dismissal of the case.

- The bill has two components: (1) it reconstitutes the mental health trust as required by the Alaska Supreme Court in a way that protects private third parties' and municipalities' title to mental health land conveyed to them, mental health land leased for resource development, mental health land in state parks and wildlife refuges, and mental health land used by state agencies, and (2) as an incentive to the mental health community for early dismissal of the litigation, it provides that the beneficiaries of the mental health trust will receive a number of benefits if the case is dismissed and the time for appeal expires by December 15, 1994

The reconstitution component

- The bill includes several findings as to the history of the Weiss litigation, the state's obligations and management options under the 1956 federal Alaska Mental Health Enabling Act, the legislature's power under the Alaska Constitution to remove land from trust status if the trust is compensated for the fair market value of the land, and how this bill serves the interests of both the beneficiaries of the mental health trust and the public
- It reconstitutes the mental health trust, as required by the Alaska Supreme Court, with some original mental health land
- For original mental health land not returned to the trust, it compensates the trust in three ways
 - Some other state land is designated as trust land
 - Past state mental health expenditures of \$1.3 billion are claimed as a set-off against state monetary liability for the fair market value of the land not returned, as authorized by the Alaska Supreme Court
 - Future state mental health expenditures are claimed as an additional set-off against state monetary liability
- Reconstituted mental health trust land will be managed by the Department of Natural Resources consistent with the state's trust obligation under the Enabling Act and, to the extent consistent with the Enabling Act, other state laws governing state land management -- i.e., the land must be managed as the Enabling Act requires but other public interests may be taken into account and accommodated to the extent the Enabling Act permits
- Municipalities returning land to the state for transfer to the trust will have two years to select other municipal entitlement land

- * The current allocation of six percent of the unrestricted general fund to the mental health trust income account is repealed

The incentive component

- * If the litigation is dismissed and the time for appeals expires with no appeals filed before December 15, 1994, the mental health community receives several benefits
- * The mental health trust authority is established largely as provided in chapter 66, SLA 1991, to oversee, coordinate, and make important decisions regarding the funding of the state's mental health program
- * The authority makes recommendations regarding amounts of state general funds needed for the state's mental health program; after considering the recommendations, the governor prepares and the legislature passes a separate appropriation bill for the program; any differences between the bill and the authority's recommendations must be explained in an accompanying report
- * The mental health trust fund from chapter 66 is established, to consist of a \$200 million up-front appropriation and trust land revenues attributable to the principal of the trust; the fund will be preserved in perpetuity and managed by the Alaska Permanent Fund Corporation to generate income
- * The mental health trust income account from chapter 66 is established, to consist of the income from the mental health trust fund and the revenues from trust land not attributable to the principal of the trust (leases, etc.); the authority will use the money in the income account for grants and contracts to implement the state's mental health program
- * The chapter 66 provisions that improve the state's mental health program become effective

Attorneys Philip Volland and Jeffrey Jessee have negotiated this bill with the Administration.

The bill reconstitutes the Mental Health Trust. Please find enclosed:

1. The lists of lands we understand the Administration agreed with Messrs. Volland and Jessee to convey to the Mental Health Trust as part of its reconstitution¹, and
2. An amendment to Section 40 for HB 201 to properly implement that agreement.

Unfortunately, we have found that the lists provided to you and located in the Commissioner's office (a) suffer from duplications, omissions and inaccurate descriptions, as well as being internally inconsistent, (b) do not accurately reflect the Administration's agreement with Mr. Volland and Mr. Jessee, and (c) in many instances, lack sufficient description to be able to accurately discern what land

¹ / There was some lack of resolution of the returnable amount of Trust Land taken by the State for use for State facilities. The State took trust land and put State buildings/facilities on some trust land. The parties agreed that the State would return the smallest practicable trust (SPT) necessary to accomplish the intended public purpose and convey the remainder to the trust. If one acre of a ten-acre parcel was required for a DOT facility, the State would retain the one-acre and the DOT facility, and return the other nine acres to the trust. These lists contain the Plaintiffs' view of SPT's. We understand the Administration agreed to provide its analysis of the SPT's required. The Administration's lists do not resolve this issue.

is intended. Except as indicated above with respect to the return of smallest practicable tracts, the enclosed land lists reflect the agreement of the parties and contain sufficient descriptions to identify the parcels.

The lists provided by the Administration contain enough problems so that the goal of enacting a "product" settlement as opposed to a "process" settlement would probably not be achieved. If the Administration's lists are used the parties will have to later either agree on what lands were supposed to have been on the lists or ask the court to make that determination.

The list of Original Trust Land is of those lands not to be returned to the Trust. All other Original Trust Lands are to be returned. The enclosed Amendment to CSHB 201 (FIN) am (Section 40) accomplishes this.

We hope this information will be of assistance to the Committee.

Delete all material and redesignate remaining paragraphs accordingly.

Insert:

TRUST CORPUS RECONSTITUTED. (a) For the purpose of reconstituting the mental health trust established under the Alaska Mental Health Enabling Act, P.L. 84-830, 70 Stat. 709 (1956) the commissioner of natural resources shall immediately convey to the mental health trust authority established under AS 47.30.011, the lands identified in subsections (b) & (c) of this section.

(b) All lands and interests in lands granted under the Alaska Mental Health Enabling Act, except the land set forth on Attachment A.

(c) In exchange for the lands granted under the Alaska Mental Health Enabling Act not to be conveyed to the trust authority under (b) of this section the lands set forth in Attachment B (Exchange Lands) shall be conveyed to the trust under section (a) of this section.

(d) The Commissioner of Natural Resources shall immediately issue to the trust authority patents to the lands to be conveyed that have been surveyed and interim conveyances to the lands that have not been surveyed. The patents and interim conveyances shall be in the form specified in the April 6, 1992 settlement agreement filed in Weiss. The patents and interim conveyances shall be recorded in the appropriate recording districts at state expense.

(e) Lands that have been conveyed by interim conveyance shall be surveyed at state expense and patents thereto subsequently issued. The surveys shall

be appropriate for the type of land involved and shall satisfy local platting requirements. The Commissioner of Natural Resources shall coordinate with the trust authority with respect to the order and timing of such surveys.

(f) The commissioner of natural resources shall convey to the trust authority all additional lands received under the Alaska Mental Health Enabling Act. The conveyances shall be in accordance with subsections (d) and (e) of this section.

(g) If it is found that any hazardous substance or substances came to be located on the lands conveyed to the trust authority prior to its conveyance such that it is not in compliance with federal, state and local laws, the state shall either remediate such land to comply with such laws or replace such land with other land of equal value and similar revenue producing potential.

The enclosed lists are my understanding of the agreement reached by Philip Volland and Julian Mason. We suggest substituting these land lists for the lists prepared by DNR to accompany the Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 201 (Fin). This would require an amendment to Sec. 41 of the bill.

The lists of lands not to be reconstituted to the Mental Health Trust are based on those we discussed with the state at the meeting in our offices on April 8, 1994 and the summary of Philip's agreement with the State as described in his April 26, 1994 summary and subsequent conversations with me.

The total acreage not reconstitutable to the Trust by our calculations is 513,770.121 acres. The state's list indicates that 556,392.082 acres are not reconstitutable to the Mental Health Trust. The difference is 42,621.961 acres.¹

I am aware of two differences in calculating non-reconstitutable acreage. First, we did not consider coal leases to be non-reconstitutable. Second, we used our determination of the parcels occupied by state agencies as shown on aerial photography. DNR's position is that even if a fractional part of a parcel is occupied by a facility or material site, the parcel is not conveyable. The state's interest can be protected by retaining only that portion of the parcel actually occupied by the facility or by reserving to the state the amount of gravel presently authorized under the terms of the agency's material sale or permit. This is what we have done.

The lists of substitute lands are based on those provided by the state. We have corrected them to delete two parcels in the Healy area that had large coal value, but appeared to be school grant lands. We added the parcels erroneously omitted from the list of "mineral estate only" lands in the Salcha area. And we added one parcel of "hydrocarbon estate only" in the Kenai area that DNR had omitted in error.

¹The lists are designed under the approach that all lands granted under the Alaska Mental Health Enabling Act will be returned except the specifically identified parcels. This is the proper method. The wording of Section 40 of HB 201 (version passed by House) would need to be modified slightly to accomplish this.

We believe that these lists are superior to the state's for several reasons. The first is that factual errors are easily identifiable. It should be easy for the parties to agree that a parcel has been omitted or deleted from a list in error. It is easier for the legislature and the public to understand the terms of the agreement. The confusion engendered on the current lists by showing the same parcel twice is avoided. Legal descriptions are provided for sub-parcels so that the intent of the parties is clear. Finally, it better protects the interests of the beneficiaries because only those named parcels are removed from the Trust.

The settling parties understand that because of the time constraints imposed on the preparation of these lists, which include literally thousands of parcels, there will be some errors and omissions. We believe these can be satisfactorily resolved after passage of CSHB 201 (FIN) am.
