A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to voter registration and to state election administration."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 15.07.070 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

4 (h) The director shall design the form of the voter's certificate appearing on
 5 the back of the large envelope that is used for voting a questioned ballot so that all
 6 information required for registration by AS 15.07.060(a) may be obtained from a voter
 7 who votes a questioned ballot. If the voter voting a questioned ballot has completed
 8 all information on the voter registration portion of the questioned ballot voter's
 9 certificate, the director shall place the name of the voter on the official registration list.

10 * Sec. 2. AS 15.07.125 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 15.07.125. OFFICIAL REGISTRATION LIST. The director shall prepare
 12 an official registration list for each election. The official registration list consists
 13 [CONSISTING] of the names of (1) all voters whose registrations appear on the
 14 master register 30 days before the election, (2) all voters whose registrations have
 15 been inactivated under AS 15.07.130(b), [ARE NOT INACTIVE;] and (3) [(2)] all

1 voters whose names are required to be placed on the list by AS 15.07.070(c) or (d).
2 The director may prepare the official registration list in sections that distinguish
3 among the three classes of registered voters set out in this section. A list of
4 persons eligible to vote in each precinct at that election shall be prepared from the
5 official registration list.

6 * Sec. 3. AS 15.07 is amended by adding a new section to read:

7 Sec. 15.07.127. PREPARATION OF VOTER REGISTRATION LISTS. The
8 director shall prepare both a statewide list and a list by precinct of the names and
9 addresses of all persons whose names appear on the official registration list maintained
10 under AS 15.07.125 and who are registered to vote and their political party affiliation.
11 Any person may obtain a copy of the list, or a part of the list, or a ^{electronic} (computer tape) format
12 containing both residence and mailing addresses of voters, by applying to the director
13 and paying to the state treasury a fee as determined by the director.

14 * Sec. 4. AS 15.07.130(c) is amended to read:

15 (c) The director shall obtain from the bureau of vital statistics a certified list
16 of all residents over 18 years of age who have died or who have been presumptively
17 declared dead. Promptly after receipt of each list, but, in any event, at least once
18 each month, the [THE] director shall cancel the registration of all deceased voters.

19 * Sec. 5. AS 15.07.135 is amended to read:

20 Sec. 15.07.135. CANCELLATION OF REGISTRATION OF CONVICTED
21 PERSONS. (a) The director shall make reasonable efforts to obtain the names of
22 persons convicted of a felony involving moral turpitude. Promptly after receipt of
23 evidence satisfactory to the director that a person has been convicted of a felony
24 involving moral turpitude, the [THE] director shall cancel the registration of the [A]
25 person [CONVICTED OF A FELONY INVOLVING MORAL TURPITUDE].

26 (b) Upon presenting proof that a [THE] person whose registration was
27 cancelled under (a) of this section has been [IS] unconditionally discharged from
28 custody, the person may register. The director shall make reasonable efforts to verify
29 the unconditional discharge of persons applying for registration under this subsection
30 [SECTION].

31 * Sec. 6. AS 15.20.203(d) is amended to read:

(d) [IF AN ABSENTEE BALLOT IS REJECTED, THE ELECTION SUPERVISOR SHALL SEND A COPY OF THE STATEMENT OF THE CHALLENGE TO THE ABSENTEE VOTER.] The election supervisor shall place all rejected absentee ballots in a separate envelope with the statements of challenge. The envelope shall be labeled "rejected absentee ballots" and shall be forwarded to the director with the election certificates and other returns.

* Sec. 7. AS 15.20.203 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(h) Not later than 60 days after the certification of the results of an election, the director shall prepare and mail to each absentee voter whose absentee ballot was rejected under this section

(1) a copy of the statement of the challenge to the absentee ballot; and

(2) a summary of the reason that the challenge to the absentee ballot was upheld and the absentee ballot was rejected.

* Sec. 8. AS 15.20.207(d) is amended to read:

(d) [IF A QUESTIONED BALLOT IS REJECTED, THE ELECTION SUPERVISOR SHALL SEND A COPY OF THE STATEMENT OF THE CHALLENGE TO THE QUESTIONED VOTER.] The election supervisor shall place all rejected questioned ballots in a separate envelope with statements of challenge. The envelope shall be labeled "rejected questioned ballots" and shall be forwarded to the director with the election certificates and other returns.

* Sec. 9. AS 15.20.207 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

(h) The director shall prepare and mail to each questioned voter whose questioned ballot was rejected under this section

(1) a copy of the statement of the challenge to the questioned ballot;

and

(2) a summary of the reason that the challenge to the questioned ballot was upheld and the questioned ballot was rejected.

(i) The director shall mail the materials described in (h) of this section to the voter not later than

(1) 10 days after the deadline set by AS 15.20.220(b) for completion of the review of ballots by the state review board for a primary election;

1 (2) 60 days after certification of the results of a general or special
2 election.

3 (j) In addition to mailing the materials under (i)(1) of this section, for a
4 questioned voter whose questioned primary election ballot was rejected, not later than
5 the deadline set out in (i)(1) of this section, the director shall

6 (1) determine whether, from the information obtained under
7 AS 15.07.070(h), the voter's name may be entered on the voter registration list;

8 (2) if the voter is eligible, register the voter in accordance with the
9 information submitted by the voter under AS 15.07.070(h); and

10 (3) confirm or deny the registration by written notice mailed to the
11 voter.

12 * Sec. 10. AS 15.20.211 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

13 (c) The director shall prepare and mail to each voter whose ballot was subject
14 to partial counting under this section

15 (1) a copy of the statement of the challenge to the ballot; and

16 (2) a summary of the reason that the challenge to the ballot was upheld
17 and the ballot was subject to only a partial counting.

18 (d) The director shall mail the materials described in (c) of this section to the
19 voter not later than

20 (1) 10 days after the deadline set by AS 15.20.220(b) for completion
21 of the review of ballots by the state review board for a primary election;

22 (2) 60 days after certification of the results of a general or special
23 election.

24 (e) In addition to mailing the materials under (d)(1) of this section, for a
25 questioned voter whose questioned primary election ballot was partially counted, not
26 later than the deadline set out in (d)(1) of this section, the director shall

27 (1) determine whether, from the information obtained under
28 AS 15.07.070(h), the voter's name may be entered on the voter registration list;

29 (2) if the voter is eligible, register the voter in accordance with the
30 information submitted by the voter under AS 15.07.070(h); and

31 (3) confirm or deny the registration by written notice mailed to the

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voter.

(a) For every area of the state designated by the director for punch-card voting, the director shall appoint a data processing review board that [WHICH] is responsible to the director for the evaluation of all computer phases of the election. The board shall consist of at least three members. A state employee may not serve as a member of the board. At least one member shall be a member of the political party whose candidate for governor received the largest number of statewide votes at the preceding general election, one shall be a member of the party whose candidate received the second largest number of votes, and one shall be registered to vote either as an "independent" or "nonpartisan" or shall have declined to state a party affiliation when registering to vote. At least one of the members must be familiar with the election process, and at least two must have some expertise in computer programming and processing. The election supervisor shall name one of the members who has sufficient familiarity with computer programming and operations as presiding officer of the board.

"An Act relating to voter registration and to state election administration; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 15.07.050 is amended to read:

Sec. 15.07.050. MANNER OF REGISTRATION [IN PERSON OR BY MAIL]. Registration may be made

(1) in person before a registration official or through a voter registration agency;

(2) [, OR MAY BE MADE] by mail; or

(3) by facsimile transmission or another method of electronic transmission that the director approves.

* Sec. 2. AS 15.07.060(a) is amended to read:

(a) Each applicant who requests registration or reregistration shall supply the following information [UNDER OATH]:

- 1 (1) name and sex;
- 2 (2) address and other necessary information establishing residence,
3 including the term of residence in the state and in the district, if requested;
- 4 (3) whether the applicant has previously been registered to vote in
5 another jurisdiction, and, if so, the jurisdiction and the address of the previous
6 registration;
- 7 (4) a declaration that the registrant will be 18 years of age or older
8 within 90 days of the date of registration;
- 9 (5) a declaration that the registrant is a citizen of the United States;
- 10 (6) date of application;
- 11 (7) signature or mark;
- 12 (8) any former name under which the applicant was registered to
13 vote in the state;
- 14 (9) an attestation that the information provided by the applicant
15 in (1) - (8) of this subsection is true; and
- 16 (10) a certification that the applicant understands that a false
17 statement on the application may make the applicant subject to prosecution for
18 a misdemeanor under this title or AS 11.

- 20 (b) To register by mail or by facsimile or other electronic transmission
21 approved by the director under AS 15.07.050, the director, the area election

Congratulations on your election win. I am aware that you have been investigating Division of Election problems. Since we perform work for almost all of the campaigns, we received an ear-full during the '94 elections.

Some of the candidates and party organizations have urged me to document these problems.

For 20 years we have worked closely with Elections personnel. From 1986 thru 1990, I was chairman of the Anchorage Elections Data Processing Review Board. Even though there has always been a high turnover in Elections staff, I have always found them to be hard working and conscientious. Much of the following is critical of Elections actions. I am not putting the blame on any staff members. Many of them became swamped with work, and worked far beyond the requirements of a normal job. Place any blame squarely on director Joe Swanson.

Attached are several problems we had or are still having. I have grouped them by:

1. Purged voters who voted without reregistering.
2. Voters assigned to the wrong district/precinct.
3. Unprocessed address changes.
4. Invalid residence addresses.
5. Data errors.
6. Data Processing Review Board Problems.

ATTACHMENT A

1. PURGED VOTERS WHO VOTED WITHOUT REREGISTERING.

Once a month the Division of Elections makes a new public version of the voters registration file available. Anyone can obtain a copy for \$165. We purchase each monthly tape. Included (since 1986) is an assension number (record number) which we use to match voters from one file to another.

By matching the state 10/17/94 public voters registration file to the 01/05/95 file on assension number, we can derive the following: The 10/17/94 file contained 339,871 registered voters which we were told included everyone that registered prior to the 10/09/94 deadline. Of those on the 10/17/94 file, 920 were not on the 1/5/95 file and 4496 voters were added. Of those that were added, 1543 had registration dates prior to 10/09/94 and also were flagged as having voted in the '94 general and with further research we found that their votes were counted. The explanation from Elections is that this occurred because of a change in the procedure for handling purged voters.

Elections is required to purge voters from the registration file if they have not voted in 2 years. The old procedure was that they had to reregister subject to a 30 day waiting period before they could vote. In this election any purged voter that showed up and voted was automatically reactivated and their vote was counted. In other words, purged voters were really still registered but were not on the public version of the voters registration file.

If this policy is going to continue, I feel you need to include these purged voters on the public voters registration file so that candidates are aware of these "unregistered" registered voters. I'm told that the 920 voters deleted from the public file are deceased people and felons that Elections is required to inactivate. It seems that most of these people should have been deleted earlier so they would not appear on the precinct lists that were printed from the 10/17/94 file. Once they show up and vote at a precinct their ballot would go into the box and there would be no way to remove it.

2. VOTERS ASSIGNED TO THE WRONG DISTRICT.

For 1994 there were minor changes in district boundaries. Elections had to reassign some voters to new district/precincts. They made some errors as can be expected since this is a tedious task. Candidates would find these errors when using our walking lists for their door-to-door campaigning. One of the larger errors had the Anchorage Pioneer home in the wrong district. Some candidates got very frustrated when it took multiple calls over a couple months to get Elections to make the corrections. There were 339 such voters including the Pioneer's home who were assigned to new districts between the September and October public files. Another 88 were redistricted after the October file was released. Any of those 443 that voted in the primary were voting for the wrong State House candidates and possibly the wrong State Senate candidates. The same may have been true for the general election for the 88 that were redistricted after October 17. Most of these problems affected Senate District J, where the final vote difference was only 26 votes. The 339 and 88 registered voters are listed in attachments C and D.

3. UNPROCESSED ADDRESS CHANGES.

One of our employees moved to a new district in November 1993. When he went to vote in the April '94 local he had not made an address change so he voted a questioned ballot and requested an address change. When he went back to vote for the primary, his address change had not been made so he again voted a questioned ballot and requested another address change. His State House and State Senate votes were not counted because he was voting where he lived rather than at his old address where the State still had him registered. When he went back in November his address change had still not been made. He again had to vote a questioned ballot and his State House and State Senate votes were again not counted. After some complaining phone calls they finally had his address changed on the November public file. My impression is that by October, the Elections office was buried in work and let some of their work load slide. During October Elections staff that normally return my phone calls in minutes would take days to get back to me. Not making timely address changes may disenfranchise a voter.

4. INVALID RESIDENCE ADDRESSES.

One of the products we produce for candidates is walking lists for their door-to-door campaigning. It has been my impression that elections is not suppose to accept a registration without a physical residence address. But the walking lists always show up with people registered at post office boxes, private box offices, state office buildings, the federal building, business addresses, vacant lots, non-existent addresses, etc. Some of these conditions Elections could check for easily, others would take a lot of work. Is there any requirement that a registered voter actually resides where they indicate? It seems unfair to a candidate that people who do not live in his district can pick an address to register at and vote in his district. A candidate should be able to notify Elections and have the voter inactivated. Another residence problem group are those that live out of state but are allowed to vote in Alaska as long as they say that they intend to return some day. They get to pick a resident address and they can pick a different address for each election. Again this seems contrary to the notion of having a elected official represent the people that live in his district.

5. DATA ERRORS.

One of the most common complaints that candidates have about the voters file is the inaccuracy of the addresses. Some candidates have us maintain private files for them with corrected addresses. They will do an address correction requested mailing to their constituents. It is normal to have 25% or more of the addresses come back, especially in a military district. I know that many years ago, Elections did an address corrected mailing and then updated mailing addresses from the post office returns. Would it be legal to update a voters residence address and possibly assign him to a new district based on a post office forwarding notice? One solution might be to send an address correction request form to a voter when the post office or a candidate indicates that the voter no longer lives at the old residence address.

6. DATA PROCESSING REVIEW BOARD PROBLEMS.

I was chairman of the Anchorage Data Processing Review Board for the '86, '88, and '90 elections. I agreed to perform that thankless job with miniscule compensation because I wanted to convince myself that the ballot counting process was accurate. And I became convinced that the procedures established were sound. The purpose of the Data Processing Review Board is to be a group of citizens who are knowledgeable about computer processing from different political parties to oversee the computer ballot counting. A major task was to punch every possible ballot configuration and verify that the ballot counting program was accurate.

I have been told some disturbing things about the '94 Data Processing Review Boards that I have not been able to verify. I repeat them to you so you can at least be aware of them.

- a. I was told that director Swanson assigned the elections supervisor in each area to their board. In 1986 we would not let the wife of one of the state programmers serve on the board because we felt it was too much of a conflict. The purpose of the board is to audit the actions of the elections supervisor. How can the elections supervisor audit herself?
- b. I was told that the board did not make up their own test decks.
- c. I was told that director Swanson rejected ballots where multiple punches were made in the same rectangular area on the governor/lieutenant governor race. It takes two punch positions on the ballot to list the governor/lieutenant governor names and party. One of the tests required of the Data Processing Review Board was to verify that if a voter punched either or both of the positions his vote would count. It is my understanding that director Swanson rejected any ballots where both positions were punched in the '94 general.

SPONSOR STATEMENT CSHB 211 (FIN)

CSHB 211 (FIN) does five things:

First, it requires the names of the inactive voters to be maintained on the official voter registration list.

Currently, the official list used at each polling place contains only the active registered voters. This proposed legislation requires the official list to also contain the inactive but registered voters. By having an official list of inactive but registered voters available at each polling place, people who have not voted within the past two years will be able to vote a regular ballot instead of a questioned ballot. This will eliminate approximately 1500-2000 questioned ballots statewide, possibly more depending upon who decides to vote.

Second, it authorizes the preparation and distribution of the voter registration list and requires the list to include active and inactive voters.

The official list will be made available to the public so any member of any district or political party will be able to obtain both active and inactive registered voters. This will give candidates and political parties the opportunity to contact inactive registered voters prior to an election. The result will probably be more voters reactivating themselves by voting.

Third, It requires the prompt purging of deceased voters and felons.

In the 1994 election, seven dead people may have voted. For this reason, HB 211 directs the division of elections to purge the official voter registration list for deceased persons on a monthly basis.

There is a gap of time between sentencing and the conviction of a felon. If the division of elections has not obtained the necessary information from the Dept. of

Corrections regarding felony convictions the names are not purged from the official voter list. Potentially, a convicted felon could vote before his/her name is purged. Section 4 of this bill directs the division of elections to promptly cancel the registration of a person convicted of a felony. After discharge from prison, a person can present proof of unconditional discharge from custody and become a registered voter again.

Fourth, It gives the Div. of Elections' division director the responsibility to provide voters with a comprehensive explanation if their absentee or questioned ballot is rejected or partially rejected.

During the 1994 primary election there were 6,990 questioned ballots statewide. That number does not include totally rejected ballots, because they are not counted as a vote on the official registration list. Of the 6,990 primary questioned ballot voters, 1,640 also voted a questioned ballot in the general election. These voters should have had appropriate corrections made before the general election in order to decrease the chance of partial or complete ballot rejection.

In the last general election there were 14,144 question ballots statewide; of these 5,131 were counted, 7,883 were partially rejected, and 1,129 were totally rejected. The explanations voters received from the Div. of Elections were not clear. The result was, that many voters did not understand why their votes were rejected.

During the last voter district reapportionment, many people who did not move from their homes changed voting districts due to boundary changes. Some of these people were not notified of the change by the Division of Elections. Their votes for their representative and Senator were rejected.

Fifth, it prohibits state employees from membership on the data processing review board.

This provision will avoid any appearance of conflict of interests.

This legislation helps to prevent problems experienced in the last election from reoccurring. I urge your positive support of CSHB 211 (FIN).



The House Finance Committee Substitute modifies and makes additions to the State Election Code, AS 15, applicable to voter registration and the administration of state elections.

Bill section 1: The changes proposed to AS 15.07.125 go to the matter of "inactive" registered voters. There are several places where, with respect to names on the master registration list, the term "inactive" seems to take on several meanings depending on the context in which it appears. Registrations, if I understand correctly, may be "active," or "inactive," or the voters' names may be purged. This bill section substantively rewrites AS 15.07.125 to impose the additional requirement that the names of voters that are inactivated are to be maintained on the state's official registration list.

Bill section 2: There is no statute that specifically authorizes purchase of voter registration lists. The Elections Division relies on some combination of administrative regulations to make the lists available for a fee. Proposed AS 15.07.127 would authorize the preparation and distribution of those lists, including all information required to be maintained on the official voter registration list.

Bill section 3 directs the Elections Division Director to purge the registration list of the names of deceased voters at least monthly.

Substantively, **bill section 4** directs revision of that registration list based on receipt of information about convicted felons "promptly."

Bill section 5 removes from AS 15.20.203(d) the responsibility imposed on the regional election supervisors to tell voters why the count of the voter's absentee vote was challenged,

while, at the same time, **bill section 6** shifts that burden to the election division director and allows the director 60 days following certification to provide a more comprehensive explanation about the disposition of that ~~absentee~~ ^{absentee} vote.

In like fashion, **bill section 7** removes from AS 15.20.207(d) the responsibility imposed on the regional election supervisors to tell voters why the count of the voter's questioned vote was challenged and, in line with that change, **bill section 8** shifts that burden to the director and allows the director a period of days following certification to provide a more comprehensive explanation about the disposition of that questioned ballot.

Similarly, **bill section 9** requires the director to prepare and provide the same kind of explanation in the event a ballot is only partially counted under the statute authorizing partial counting of cross-district ballots and counting of names of write-in candidates on certain ballots provided to the voter in error.

Bill section 10: For purposes of oversight of punch-card voting and other aspects of computerized elections operations, state law requires the director to appoint a data processing review board. The change made in this section would preclude the director from appointing state employees--especially persons who are subordinates of the director--to that board.

Dear Representative Bunde:

First, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you and your assistant Patti Swenson for all the hard work and assistance on election legislation this session. It is very exciting to see this effort getting close to passage.

Incorporation of the proposed sections of HB 349 into HB 211 will assist the Division of Elections to conform statutory language in several sections of Title 15, Elections, to current federal requirements for state elections as set out in the National Voter Registration Act:

- Sections 2, 17 and 18 remove the requirement that a person registering to vote must sign "an oath." This practice is not allowed in federal law. [There is a conceptual error in the proposed title of Section 7: (page 4 line 2) Preparation of Voter Registration Lists should read Preparation of the Master Register. This correction is by agreement between Rep. Bunde and the Div. of Elections.]
- Sections 7, 8 and 10 correct the perception that Alaska purges inactive voters from voter lists after too short a period of inactivity. This bill lengthens the period from two years to four years and reduces the number of voters required to vote a questioned ballot.

[There is a conceptual error in Section 10: (page 5 line 5-8.) That the voter's registration will be canceled if the voter does not vote or appear to vote in an election held during the period beginning on the date of the notice and ending on the day after the date of the fourth [SECOND] general election that occurs after the date of notice; . . . This section should read: ending on the last day of the fourth calendar year . . . or remain as it is in present statute. Otherwise, a voter who has been inactive for four years would

remain on the roles for an additional eight years instead of an additional four years.]

- Section 24 will disallow a voter's employer or union official or agent from acting as a personal representative for the voter. This amendment conforms to federal law.

Sections 1, 3, 4 and 5 allow Alaska's citizens to request registration materials by FAX or other electronic means and to return registration applications to the division by FAX.


This bill is also a "housekeeping" bill for the division. Sections 6, 15, 16, 19, 22, 23, 25, 27, 28, 30, 31, 33 - 36 conform statutory language to more accurately describe the ballot and envelope forms now available to voters. Sections 20, 26, 37, and 45 set out dates for processing election results to reflect increased efficiency.

Sections 41-44 describe the current ballot tabulation methods and security needed to conduct an election.

Finally, Section 47 and 48 reflect the increased cost of providing voters with printed election information on candidates and issues.

Both Kathleen Strasbaugh of the Department of Law and Legislative Liaison Diane Shriner will be available to answer any questions you or the committee may have. This bill carries a zero fiscal note and was passed out of House State Affairs without objection. Thank you for your further consideration.

The draft modifies and makes additions to the State Election Code, AS 15, applicable to voter registration and the administration of state elections.

Bill section 1: The amendment proposed to AS 15.07.050 authorizes voter registration by fax (facsimile transmission) or other method of electronic transmission.

Bill section 2: The amendment deletes the requirement that registration be given under oath, adds to the content of the registration declaration, and provides that the information is to be attested as true, subject to prosecution under the appropriate criminal provision.

Bill sections 3, 4, and 5: The amendments to AS 15.07.070(b), (c), and (f) expand registration-by-mail provisions to cover voter registration by fax. An additional change in AS 15.07.070(b) conforms language and a statutory reference to current drafting style.

Bill section 6: The division, proposing to change the terms used with reference to preserving secrecy in casting questioned ballots, deletes the modifier from the term used for the enclosing document that bears the questioned voter's certificate.

Bill section 7: This addition to AS 15.07 would require the division director to prepare statewide voting lists and precinct voting lists from the state's master register and sets out how an interested person may obtain copies of the lists. (There is no statute that specifically authorizes purchase of voter registration lists. The Elections Division relies on some combination of administrative regulations to make the lists available for a fee. This provision would authorize the preparation and distribution of those lists.)

Bill section 8: This amendment of AS 15.07.130(b) expands the period in which a voter may vote in order to avoid being purged, and authorizes cancellation of the voter on the registration list only if the voter fails to vote or appear to vote.

Bill section 9: The amendment of AS 15.07.130(c) directs the Elections Division Director to purge the registration list of the names of deceased voters at least monthly.

Bill section 10: The change to AS 15.07.130(d) further refines the manner of canceling a voter's registration for failure to vote or appear to vote, delaying the cancellation until the fourth general election after giving notice of proposed cancellation under AS 15.07.130(b).

Bill section 11: The provision supplies a definition to the phrase "appears to vote." ("Appears to vote" is part of the federal Voter Registration Law where it is offered without a definition.)

Substantively, **bill section 12** directs revision of that registration list based on receipt of information about convicted felons "promptly."

Bill section 13: Elsewhere, AS 15.07.170 is repealed. This section makes a conforming change.

Bill section 14: Election reform legislation last year (ch. 58, SLA 1995) revised personnel provisions applicable to the division of elections. The change made here belatedly reflects and ties in the appointment of regional election supervisors to the revised requirements.

Bill section 15 deletes the specific dimensions of the squares appearing on ballots as places in which the voter may indicate a choice.

Bill section 16 deletes a dated reference to kinds of materials, both of which are covered within the definition of "ballot."

Bill section 17 deletes the requirement that inactive voters cast questioned or absentee ballots "under oath" and, in conjunction with changes made in **bill section 18**, substitutes use of a "declaration."

Bill section 19 revises the questioned ballot process, and substitutes references to "secrecy sleeve" and "envelope" for the existing language used to describe the containers into which voted ballots are placed.

Bill section 20 amends the description of the period during which the state counting review is to be conducted, indicating that it is to commence "as soon as practicable" after the election is completed.

Bill section 21 recasts the statement of authority under which a voter is entitled to vote an absentee ballot by eliminating reference to specific circumstances set out in current law.

As in bill section 6, **bill sections 22, 23, and 25** change the terms used with reference to preserving secrecy in casting absentee ballots.

Bill section 24 adds to the list of persons who may not serve as personal representative for a voter.

Bill section 26 amends the manner by which ballot counting boards are selected to reflect the fact that major political party status is not limited to the two traditional political parties.

In addition to changing a term used with reference to preserving secrecy in casting absentee ballots, the amendment to AS 15.20.201(b) made by **bill section 27** makes clear that the count of absentee ballots may not begin before the polls close on the evening of an election.

Bill sections 28, 30, and 31 change the terms used with reference to preserving secrecy in casting absentee ballots.

Bill section 29 removes from AS 15.20.203(d) the responsibility imposed on the regional election supervisors to tell voters why the count of the voter's absentee vote was challenged, while, at the same time, **bill section 32** shifts that burden to the election division director and allows the director a set number of days following certification to provide a more comprehensive explanation about the disposition of that absentee vote.

Bill sections 33, 35, and 36 change the terms used with reference to preserving secrecy in casting absentee ballots.

Bill section 37 adds two days to the time in which the district questioned ballot board may complete its work and issue its certificate.

As with absentee votes, **bill section 34** removes from AS 15.20.207(d) the responsibility imposed on the regional election supervisors to tell voters why the count of the voter's questioned vote was challenged and, in line with that change, **bill section 38** shifts that burden to the director, allows the director a period of days following certification to provide a more comprehensive explanation about the disposition of that questioned ballot, and requires the director to ascertain, from information provided, whether the questioned voter may be properly re-registered.

Similarly, **bill section 39** requires the director to prepare and provide the same kind of explanation in the event a ballot is only partially counted under the statute authorizing partial counting of cross-district ballots and counting of names of write-in candidates on certain ballots provided to the voter in error.

Bill section 40: For purposes of oversight of punch-card voting and other aspects of computerized elections operations, state law requires the director to appoint a data processing review board. The change made in this section would preclude the director from appointing state employees--especially persons who are subordinates of the director--to that board.

Bill sections 41 - 44 make a series of technical changes relating to the state's conduct of punch-card voting.

Bill section 45 adds two days to the time in which the questioned punch-card ballots are to be counted.

Bill section 46: This amendment affects elections conducted by mail. The provisions cited authorize, in an election by mail, the use of absentee ballots. The specific amendment adds in a cross-reference to subsection (f), a technical addition that authorizes a voter casting an absentee vote in an election by mail to offer or supply proper identification affirming the voter's identity.

Bill sections 47 and 48 double the fees for filing material to be inserted in the state's general election pamphlet.

Bill section 49 repeals provisions denying the electoral franchise to persons judicially determined to be of unsound mind (AS 15.05.040) and a criminal provision governing the making of false statements in registering as a voter (AS 15.07.170).

Bill section 50 gives the measure an immediate effective date.

SPONSOR STATEMENT SCSCSHB 211

"An Act relating to voter registration and to state election administration; and providing for an effective date."

The purpose of SCSCSHB 211 is to meet the requirements of the National Voter Registration Act of 1993. This requirement and a number of housekeeping issues are accomplished in this legislation.

This legislation will make voter registration easier for many Alaskans. **Sections 1,3,4, and 5** of this legislation allow people to register to vote by fax or other electronic means.

People who are registering to vote will not be required to sign an oath under this proposed legislation. **Sections 2, 17 and 18** remove the requirement for an oath upon initial registration or for a person whose registration is inactive and who votes a questioned or absentee ballot. Section 2 also requires specific information from a voter in order to register to vote by fax or other electronic means.

Currently, when a voter is not active for a period of two years their name is placed on an inactive voter list. This list is not available to consumers who buy the voter list from the Division of Elections. **Sections 7, 8, and 10** of this legislation will correct that problem by keeping voters on the master register for four years instead of two years. The effect of leaving names on the master register for four years will be to decrease the number of questioned ballots used at the polls during an election. Additionally, names of voters who have been inactive for a while will be available when a voter list is purchased.

During the last general election there were 14,144 questioned ballots statewide. Of these 5,131 ballots were totally counted, 7,883 ballots were partially rejected, and 1,129 ballots were totally rejected. Many people were unaware that their votes for district representative and senator did not count. **Sections 19, 23, 25, 27, 28, 29, 30-39 and 45**, contain improved procedures for absentee and questioned ballots. Some of these changes will decrease the number of repeat questioned ballots used in an election cycle and will increase the amount of communication between the Division of Elections, absentee voters, and questioned ballot voters. This bill directs the Division of Elections to notify a voter of the status of a vote challenge no later than 10 days after the certification of the primary when a questioned or absentee ballot is totally rejected or partially rejected in the primary. When a ballot is totally rejected or partially rejected the Director of the Division of Elections must notify the voter within sixty days of certification of the general election.

Sections 9 and 12 of this bill direct the Division of Elections to purge deceased voters monthly, and **convicted** felons promptly. Currently, there is a gap of time between conviction and sentencing of a felon. If the Division of Elections does not obtain the necessary information from the Dept. of Corrections regarding felony convictions the names are not purged from the official voter list. Potentially, a convicted felon could vote before his/her name is purged.

This legislation clarifies the description of the ballot and envelope forms available to voters in **sections 6, 15, 16, and 22**.

The 1994 Election Data Review Board was largely made up of state employees. This legislation requires that our states Election Data Review Board be as impartial as possible. **Section 40** of SCSCSHB 211 prohibits the appointment of any state employees to the Data Processing Review Board. This provision will keep the data processing review board objective and impartial. The appointment of district counting boards is broadened in this legislation. Currently, the district counting boards for absentee and questioned ballots are composed of four members, two from each political party. Our state has more than two parties. **Section 26** of this legislation requires the same four members, but one member must be from the same party as the governor, and one member must be a member of the party whose gubernatorial candidate received the second largest number of votes in the last election.

Sections 41-44 describe the current ballot tabulation methods and security needed to conduct an election.

Sections 47 and 48 reflect the increased cost of providing voters with printed election information on candidates and issues.

In the 1994 election the many voters who were not aware of the status of their vote were disenfranchised. Additionally, far too many voters were forced to vote questioned ballots in the primary and the general elections because important information was not changed in a timely manner. This bill provides a means of decreasing the number of questioned ballots cast in our state and corrects many other flaws in our state election statutes. We all know one vote can change the outcome of an election. Give all the voters in our state the opportunity to have their vote counted, and give our Division of Elections the opportunity to help our election process change and become more effective. I urge your positive consideration of this legislation.
