activities that bring unwanted police to the reservation.

"We would require all our retailers to buy from the Seneca Nation," he said. "If a little mom-and-pop store on Bush Road wanted 100 cases of cigarettes, we'd say no. Because we know where they would be going."

"We've told them, we have no problem shutting down the bootleggers," he said of past talks with the state. "We're not proud of them."

Dallagh never mentioned Linda Muhawk by name, but her store is on Bush Road.

"I don't feel the Arab people are abusing me," she added, because I'm making money from them."

But the money, said her attorney Gollo, is nowhere near the millions of dollars the state feels is leaving the reservation in untaxed cigarettes.

"We wish it were that lucrative," he said. "Is there a lot of money changing hands in the industry? Yes. These guys are running through an awful lot of cigarettes."

State paid for warehouse

Newports, Salems, Marlboros and Kouls, thousands of tax-free cartons of the most popular brands of American cigarettes, start their journey to Detroit or Dearborn from a warehouse in Salamanca.

The A.D. Bedell Co. is an odd part of state economic development efforts. State and federal money built the \$1 million warehouse — originally for the Fancher Furniture company — but it is now filled with millions of dollars in untaxed cigarettes that don't bring a single penny to the state.

Bedell rents the warehouse from its owner, Salamanca Community Development, which justifies the lease for the 60 jobs it provides.

Would Salamanca have put up the warehouse originally to store untaxed cigarettes?

"I doubt it," said Nancy Milligan, the general manager of the city agency. "But when you have a mortgage to pay . . ."

Page Martin, the fifth generation of his family to run A.D. Bedell, said his sales to the Indians are perfectly legal.

"If I don't do it, someone else will," he said. "I had a lot of customers who were disgruntled when I got into this in 1988. I told them, 'wouldn't you rather know who is involved?' All of my forms are filed with the state. I don't pull any punches."

Bedell, along with Milheim Attea & Brothers in Buffalo and a third wholesaler in northern New York, supplies the majority of the reservation smokeshops.

Bedell's owner said he knows some of his cigarettes help fill a steady stream of rental vans headed to Michigan to beat a tax of \$7.50 a carton.

"If they stop the cigarettes here, they'll just go in North Carolina or South Carolina," he said. "Here it's just closer."

"mules" — and each van that makes it to Michigan brings back at least \$8,000 profit.

Indian smokeshop owners, who buy their premium cigarettes for \$12 a carton from Bedell, clear \$600 to \$3,000 for a few minutes handling a van.

It's simple work. Cigarettes are packed 20 to a pack, 10 packs to a carton and 60 cartons to a case. A case, worth about \$1,500 retail, weighs no more than a few pounds and stacks easily.

"The tax increase in Michigan," Stamler reported, "has made cigarette smuggling more profitable than narcotics trafficking and less risky."

Brokering in cigarettes

Senecas or Tuscaroras legally can buy any quantity of tax-free cigarettes from wholesalers in New York by showing proof they are members of the nation.

"For \$2,000 to \$5,000, you can set yourself up and make a lot of money," said a Seneca who opposes cigarette sales by private individuals. "If I had gone into it four or five years ago, I'd be a multimillionaire right now."

Why didn't he? "Basically, all they're doing is brokering," he said. "They're not making a product. People who sell cigarettes don't have respect in the nation. We have people in the Seneca Nation who are out for themselves. They are not trying to support the nation."

The Seneca Nation's own smokeshops as well as those owned by some of the nation's most prominent businessmen refuse to sell to smugglers, according to investigators whose undercover buyers were rebuffed.

Other smokeshop owners say it's not worth the trouble.

"I'm not going to wait around for four hours so I can hand some-

last two years have Arab sounding surnames.

"The Arab community is very large in Michigan," said Joseph Sarafa, executive director for the Associated Food Dealers of Michigan.

"It is also very significantly into the type of business, convenience stores, delis and supermarkets, that sell cigarettes," he said.

Leonard Walentynowicz, a lawyer who has defended those charged in the smuggling, suggests state police may be targeting Arab-Americans — a charge they deny — but also acknowledged that those he represents and charged with cigarette tax evasion are active in the retail field.

"The Yemmi people, the Arabs, they're merchants by trade," Walentynowicz said. "They're not truck layers, they're not steelworkers. They're merchants. They buy merchandise in the locations that offer a favorable price. They are not nefarious people."

At least six of those caught in the last two years by state police either own or have ties to Arab-American delis in Buffalo, Lackawanna or Niagara Falls.

Selling cigarettes in New York requires tax stamps to show the \$5.40-a-carton tax has been paid.

Mohamed Ali Abubakar, 27, of Niagara Falls, one of those caught by state police with tax-free reservation cigarettes, was arrested again this month on charges of possessing phony tax stamps.

In defense of smuggling

Not everyone thinks the transfer of tax-free cigarettes from the reservations to Michigan is a crime.

"It's not smuggling," Walentynowicz contended. "The state has abrogated its right to collect the sales tax on the reservations."

Those caught on their way to Michigan with tax-free cigarettes may or may not be trying to avoid paying Michigan's taxes — Walentynowicz never admits his clients are doing wrong — but they surely are not avoiding New York's taxes, he says.

Chautauque County Judge John Ward made just such a ruling in a trial of a Michigan man who was acquitted in May. Ward told jurors that, if they did not believe the defendant intended to to resell the cigarettes in New York, he was not evading New York's sales tax.

Only Friday, Ward dismissed another set of charges against another Michigan man for basically the same reason.

Prosecution continues

Despite the ruling, state police say they will continue to arrest drivers of vans leaving the reservations laden with thousands of tax-free cartons of cigarettes.

Melvin Parker, an attorney with the state Department of Taxation and Finance who is prosecuting the tax cases, said other judges continue to convict the cigarette smugglers and said the fines have ranged from \$500 to \$4,000.

Possessing more than 300 cartons of tax-free cigarettes also is a federal crime, and the U.S. attorney in Buffalo recently indicted two people on charges of cigarette smuggling.

State police say so much smuggling is going on they are limited only by the number of officers they have out looking for smugglers.

"We're probably catching no more than 5 or 10 percent of them," said Feldmann, the State Police investigator.

Cigarettes from area reservations used to evade taxes elsewhere

On a recent chilly night on the Seneca Nation's Cattaraugus Reservation, a few miles from the Thruway exit at Irving, State Police Investigator Bernie Feldmann watched a loading operation at an smoke shop called Roseine's.

It was 7:30 p.m., an unusual time for most business deliveries, but a big van from A. Salamanca tobacco wholesaler was backed up at Roseine's drive, and two smaller passenger vans were next to it, their tailgates open.

As Feldmann made several passes by the smokeshop in an unmarked police car, he watched

workers loading cases of cigarettes into the two vans.

These were untaxed cigarettes, part of the millions of dollars in contraband smokes that have traveled along a new smuggling corridor in the last three years from Western New York to Michigan.

The smuggling has drawn little attention, but Michigan authorities say they have lost \$44 million since they tripled their tax rate in 1994.

A third of those untaxed cigarettes, they believe, come from
