History of The Four Dam Pool

“We repeat the errors of history
because we forget.”

The Initial Project

- Constructed/Acquired 1981 - 1985
 - Lake Tyee serving Petersburg/Wrangell
 - Solomon Gulch serving Valdez/Glennallen
 - Swan Lake serving Ketchikan
 - Terror Lake serving Kodiak
- Cost: \$500 million (\$300 million cost over-run under state, local, and engineer management)
 - Financed by bonds then replaced by state loan

Power Sales Agreement (PSA)

October 1985

- Parties:

- Cities of Ketchikan, Petersburg, Wrangell
- Copper Valley Electric Association, Inc.
- Kodiak Electric Association, Inc.
- Alaska Power Authority

History cont'd

Perceptions

- 5 Utilities:
“...the utilities would only pay operating costs with no obligation to repay capital costs...” p2
- The State:
utilities must repay some of the capital costs in view of the “cost over-runs”

PSA Responsibilities

- 5 Utilities: Operation and maintenance (O&M) insurance, routine replacements, administration, and debt service, on a kilowatt hour basis, limited by “self help clause”
- State: Risks of facility performance failures, insufficiency in R&R Fund, uninsured losses, inflation, power sales losses, and catastrophic events

History cont'd

1993 Legislative Reorganization

- Alaska Power Authority (APA) changed to Alaska Energy Authority (AEA) and its responsibilities given to the AIDEA Board
- An Alaska State “Energy Policy” was put in place to include Power Cost Equalization (PCE) and a host of other programs (interties) and legislative understandings (blackmail clause)

5 Utilities sue the State

- Filed in April 1995 for State to pay for repairs
- Settled June 1995 (Legal or Political)
- Administration: Proposed bonding \$25 million
- Legislature: Decided to use debt service payments as “self help” to pay for repairs
- impact on State budgets and the PCE fund
 - \$27 million

History cont'd

Terror Tunnel Repairs - 1994

- Expected cost \$1.8 million
 - Out one construction season
 - Expected benefit: significant energy production increases
 - “...the repair project went badly... [no] increase in energy production... work...not completed...” p3

History cont'd

Terror Tunnel Repairs - 1996

- Projected Costs \$3,850,000
- Harza Engineers (engineering & CM) \$ 700,026
- Observation:
The CM fee of Harza more than trebled
from budget \$ 128,000 to committed \$ 387,826

History cont'd

Tyee Transmission Line

- Projected Costs \$19,906,528
 - Power Engineers:
 - Engineering & CM Committed \$1,598,876
- Anecdotal comments by employees: “Line only touched the ground twice in 10 years because of snow berm”

History cont'd

Sale of Four Dam Pool

- How the 5 Utilities characterized the sale
 - “That legislation [1993 Legislation] directed the AEA to seek ways to turn over ownership and control of AEA projects to the utilities.”
Position Paper P. 4. (emphasis added)
- No such direction is in that legislation
- A line item in the 1995 Legislative Appropriation provided funds to sell the Four Dam Pool

History cont'd

Sale's Effort

- Essentially a “Sole-Source Arrangement”
- The PMC crafted a Memorandum of Understanding, August 2, 1995 “...for negotiation of an ownership transfer.” P. 4 (emphasis added)
- February 1996 meeting... “AEA shocked the Utilities by proposing... (1) pay...\$84 million, (2) assume costs of repairing (3) assume all-risks. The utilities ended negotiations ...proposal is so far from anything ...reasonable ...” P. 6

History cont'd

5 Utilities' Position

- “The utilities determined that the...risks they would assume is high enough that it essentially offsets value...they believe the basic deal needs to be that the price they pay the State is to accept (and therefore relieve the State from) the significant risks facing AEA over the next few decades.” P. 6
- Sole-Source “transfer” efforts at an impasse after 2 years

End of History

State Development Policy

- A guide for the disposition of the Four Dam Pool
- “ it is in the state’s interest to import private capital to create new economic activity which would not otherwise take place in the state.”
Alaska Statutes 44.88.010(11)
- “...to promote, develop, and advance the general prosperity and economic welfare of the people of Alaska...” Alaska Statutes 44.88.070

What is the Public Interest?

- 1st The interests of all Alaskans resides in the ownership of the dams. This interest is paramount. Securing the highest “fair value” satisfies this constituency.
- 2nd The interests of consumers and of employees who operate the dams are satisfied by lowering the cost of producing power, providing reliability, and long term stable employment.

Efficiency

- Efficiency is the linchpin to successfully address consumer interests
- Governments and public organizations secure efficiency through the discipline of oversight
- Private organizations secure efficiency through the discipline of competition

Competition

- Utilities were thought to serve consumers best as monopolies
- Technology and the experience of the last 20 years demonstrate that a competitive marketplace best serves the interests of consumers
- Public policies to create a competitive market for utility type economic activity are privatization and deregulation
