Analysis

The resolution requests that the Department of Law, in concert with others, conduct a comprehensive review of the Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) for Norton Sound OCS Lease Sale No. 57 to determine whether the state's interests, including interests in fisheries, were adequately represented in the EIS process, and to determine whether the EIS process for Norton Sound has been properly and lawfully observed by the federal government. The department's legal review of environmental impact statements concerned with state programs or resources is a long established duty and, consequently, fiscal impact will not occur.
