5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing the Alaska Power Authority to
7 transfer certain projects to public utilities; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. Notwithstanding AS 44.83.380 -- 44.83.425, the Alaska
11 Power Authority may transfer the following projects to appropriate public
12 utilities: *City of Kobuk & Port Lions*

13 (1) Port Lions transmission line, funded by sec. 1, ch. 90, SLA 1981,
14 as amended by sec. 69, ch. 92, SLA 1981;

15 (2) Kobuk - Shungnak transmission line, funded by sec. 4, ch. 90, SLA
16 1981.

17 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
