

Dear sir;

A man sure feels frustrated when he gets interrupted in mid-polemic, but I can appreciate your desire to keep things rolling. However, the statement I had in mind was both briefer and more to the point than some other comments in today's tele-conference. To say nothing of being more original and less repetitive than some.

Like you, the teleconference network, is the people's instrument. It seems highly appropriate to maximize the usefulness of our imperfect instruments to communicate with each other on topics of common interest. Toward that end, may I ask that you circulate this letter, and the enclosure to the other members of your committee? Thanks.

There is no action more severe than extermination. The previous fish board voted that, for us, repeatedly. Driving us into court, time after time, since 1976, and finally to the Supreme Court for the Madison decision. Despite that experience, we were appalled at the wholesale slaughter, by John Shiveley's Nat'l Resources Transition team, of the Boards of Fisheries and Game.

We have heard no convincing evidence that Bix Bonney is guilty of any misconduct. He does take hard stands on controversial issues. I like that, I know where he stands regarding our proposals: he opposes them. I'm not going to whine about honest differences of opinion.

Right now, those Boards need continuity -- a chance to redevelop the institutional memory and authority mislaid three years ago.

Enclosed find a statement I drafted two years ago, which was unanimously endorsed by the local advisory committee and disseminated. Many of us are concerned that these citizen boards will be lost if administrations and legislatures cannot resist meddling beyond the limits of proper concern. If you want to do something to further the work of the boards, think of mechanical improvements to lessen the work load; how about regionalization of some policy and regulation making? Think about the boards, regional council and advisory committee budgets. Think about augmenting the teleconference system as a substitute for more expensive meetings. We're available to help in all respects. Call on us at will.

FROM THE HOMER FISH AND GAME ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Every Alaskan who wishes to participate in the determination of the property management of fish and wildlife is entitled to be heard by all members of the Boards of Fisheries and Game in a fair and impartial manner.

To accomplish this purpose, and to assure the conservation and development of these resources, appointments and confirmations should not be politically manipulated.

Members of these boards are entrusted with making public policy and for dedication to the fish and wildlife of Alaska. No identification should be made between the policy-makers and any particular segment of the population or the interests of any particular region.

In 1957, the Territorial legislature established a fish and game commission to be composed of three commercial fishermen representing specific areas, one hunter, one trapper, and one sport fisherman. During consideration of the Statehood Act, the U.S. Congress determined that this commission was not acceptable because it purposely delegated control of fish stocks to the commercial fishing industry and excluded natives from the process.

Congress withheld fish and wildlife management from the State until an impartial system was adopted. In 1959, the State legislature enacted a statute establishing a Board of Fish and Game "composed of eight members having a general knowledge of the fish and game resources of the state and selected without regard to political affiliations or special interest". On January 5th, 1960, President Eisenhower transferred the administration and management of fish and game from the federal government to the state.

In 1975, the legislature split the single state board into two seven member boards; one for fisheries and one for game, and required that they be appointed and confirmed "without regard to political affiliation or geographical location of residence". The prohibited reasons for appointment seem to be primarily honored in the breach; all five governors have appointed persons because of their place of residence, their identification with particular groups, or a vested interest in a particular activity.

In this highly political environment it is no wonder that the allocation process has become a breeding ground for lawsuits and that finite fish and wildlife resources sometimes suffer from confused management.

Our boards should not be political instruments. They should be made up of independent people of character with a good knowledge of the subject who are obligated only to the welfare of wildlife. To reduce the number of lawsuits and the amount of political pressure on the Department of Fish and Game, all parties to allocation disputes should unite in a common effort to de-politicize the fish and wildlife decision making process.

We all depend, for one thing or another, on these resources.
