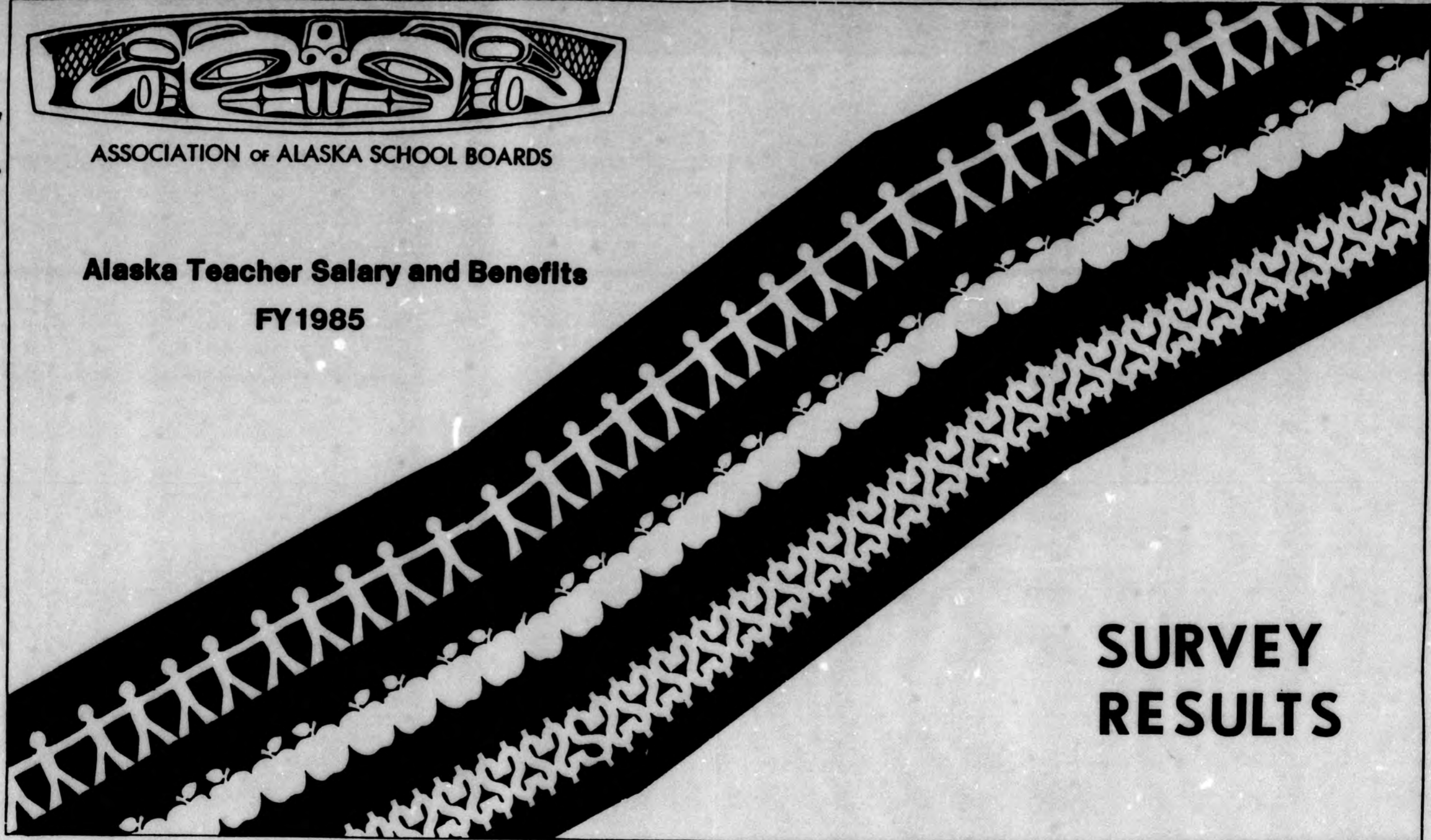

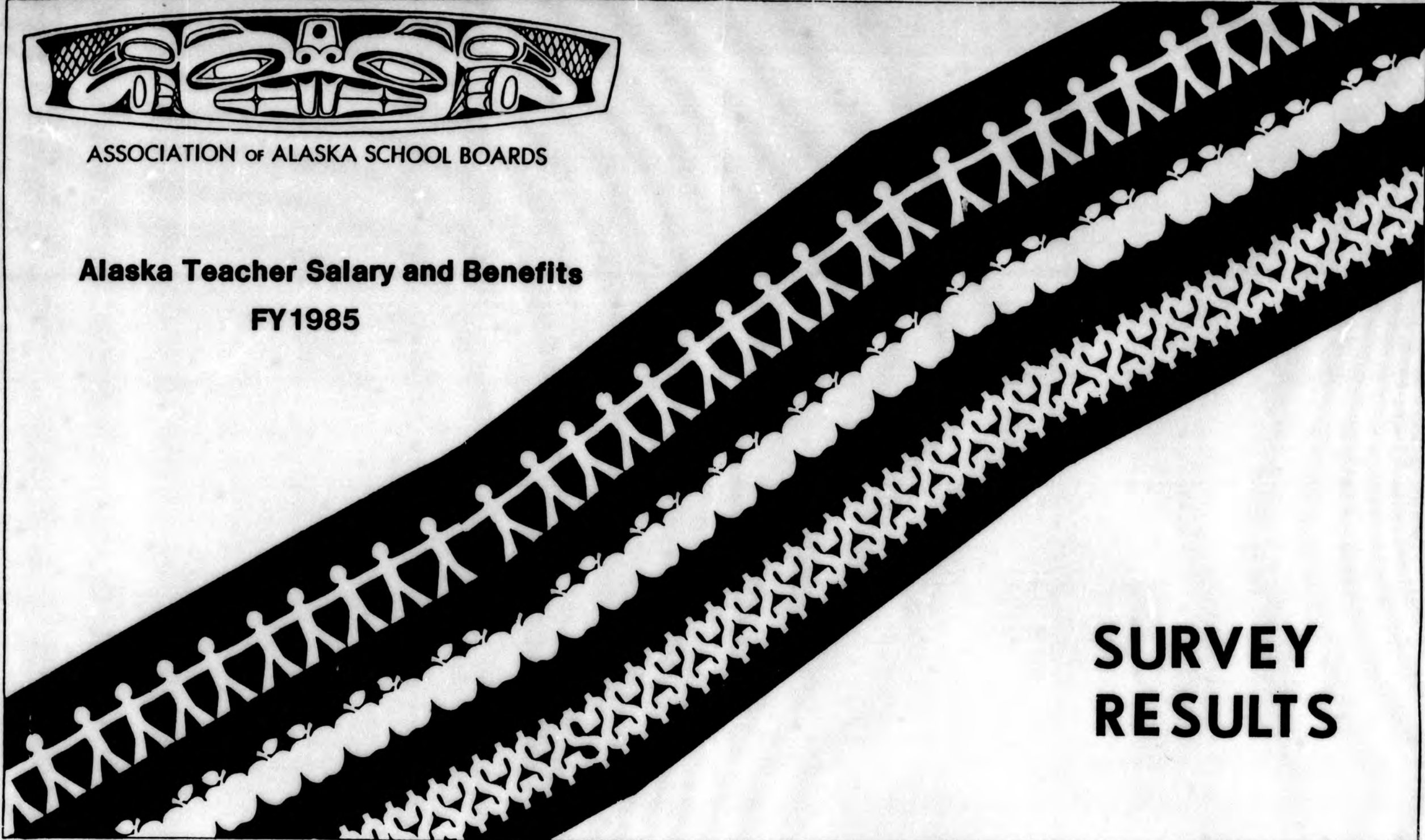

This edition of the Annual Report of Salaries and Benefits marks a new format for the report. In past years, the salary and benefit survey included relatively brief information on teachers, certified and non-certified administrators, and classified employees. Because of the school districts' need for more detailed information for internal management and for negotiations, we have decided to produce the annual survey in three separate reports, one for each class of employees. This has allowed us to provide more comprehensive information, which we hope will prove more useful to school boards and administrators.

The format for this new report features not only detailed information for each district but facilitates comparability of that information by grouping it in separate sections according to region of the state. The report also includes a summary of the information most commonly requested by school districts, both on a statewide basis and by region.

This 1984-85 Annual Report is also new in another way. It was designed specifically in response to the recommendations made to AASB by the Database Advisory Board, comprised of several superintendents, personnel directors and business managers from school districts which are members of AASB's Database Consortium. Their willingness to share their knowledge and expertise is greatly appreciated.

AASB would like to express special thanks to the central office staff members in each of the school districts who took the time to provide us with the information we requested through extensive surveys and numerous follow-up phone calls. Without their patience and cooperation this report would not be possible.

Special recognition goes to Donn Liston, AASB's overworked, underpaid, dedicated Database Secretary for his willingness to enter and re-enter survey information because of seemingly endless revisions. His diligence was instrumental in getting out a complete report.

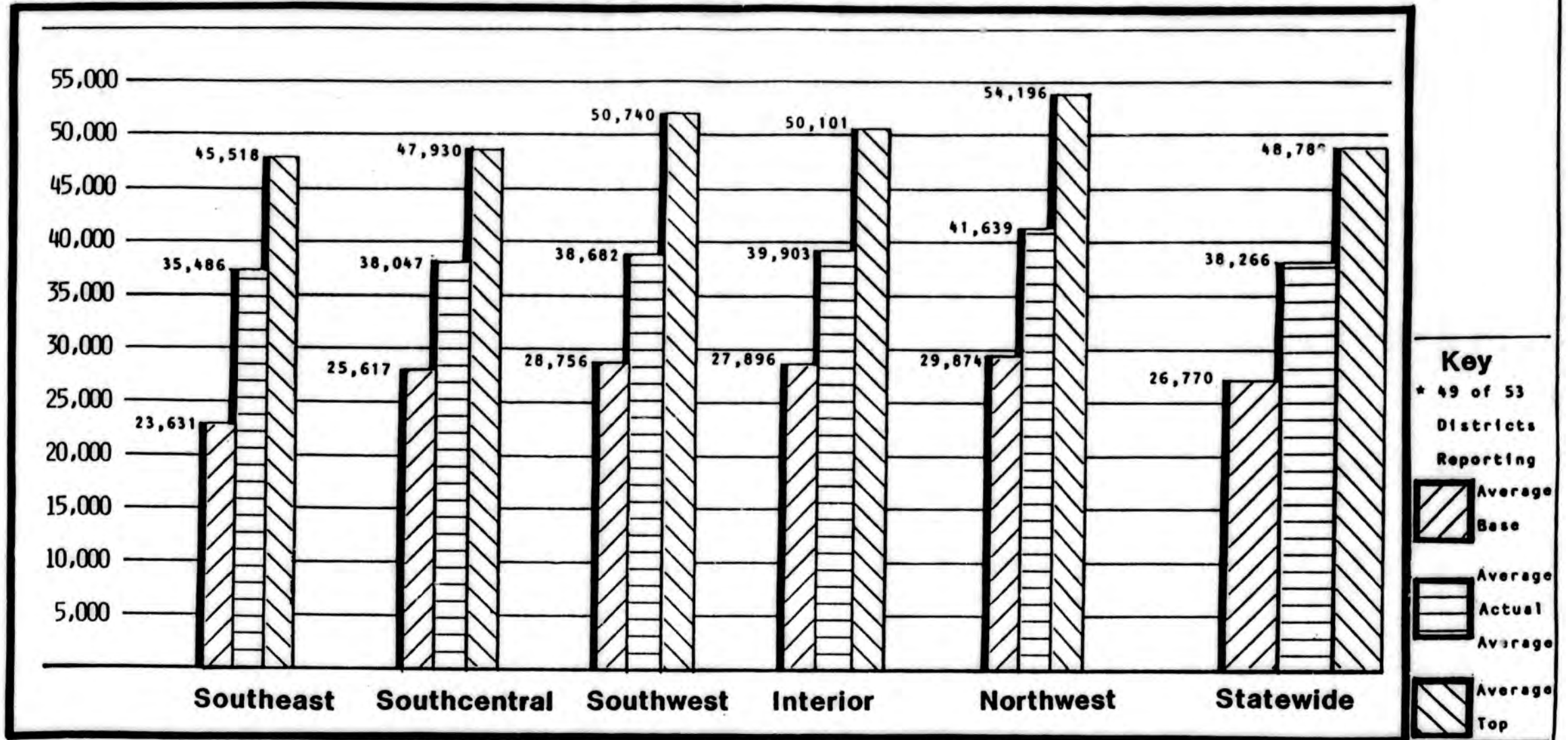

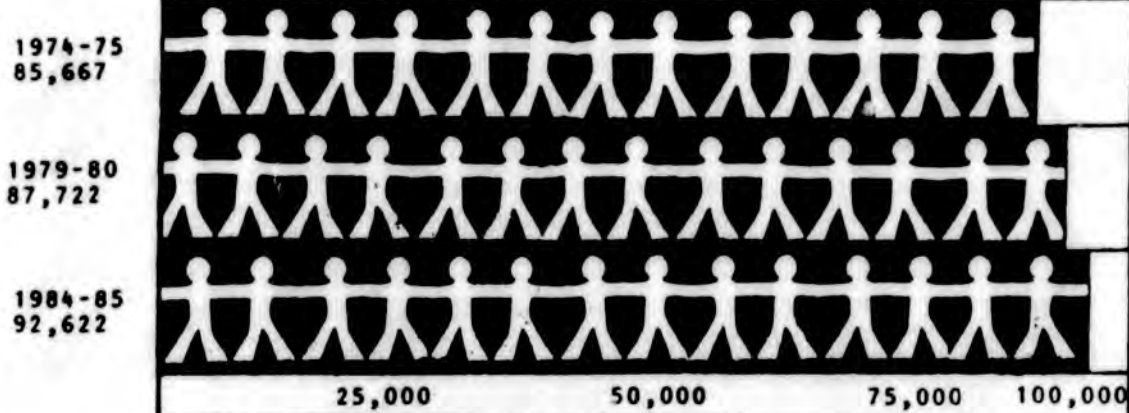
Average Teacher Salaries FY1985

By Region and Statewide



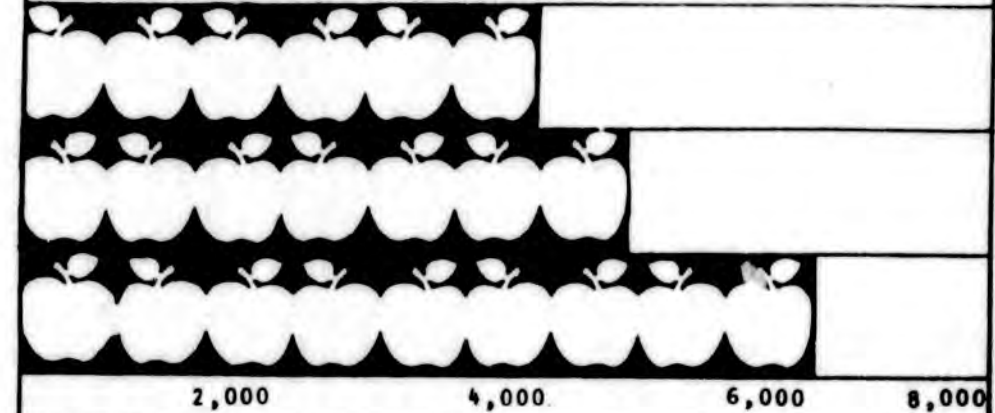
Pupil Enrollment

Slow Growth in number of students attending Alaska schools, with an 8.1% overall increase, from 85,667 ADM in 1974-75 to 92,622 in 1984-85.

Classroom Teachers

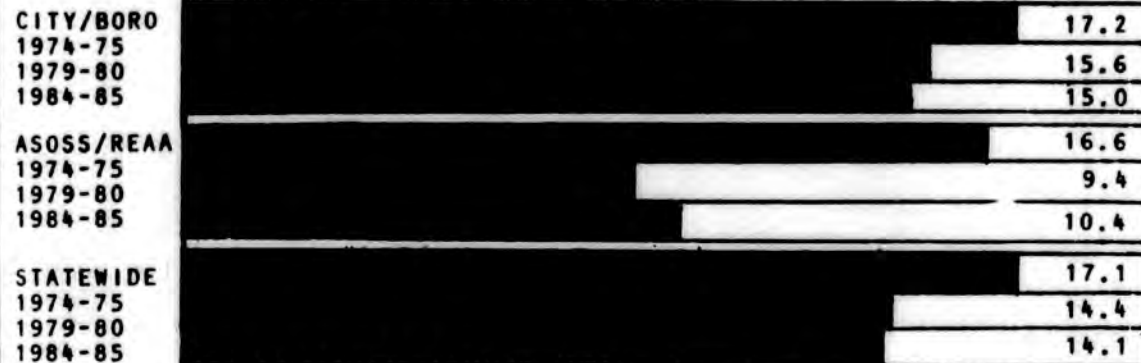


CERTIFIED CLASSROOM TEACHERS:

Major Increase of 53.2% between 1974-75 and 1984-85 due partially to establishment of new rural high schools as mandated by the Tobeluk Consent Decree.

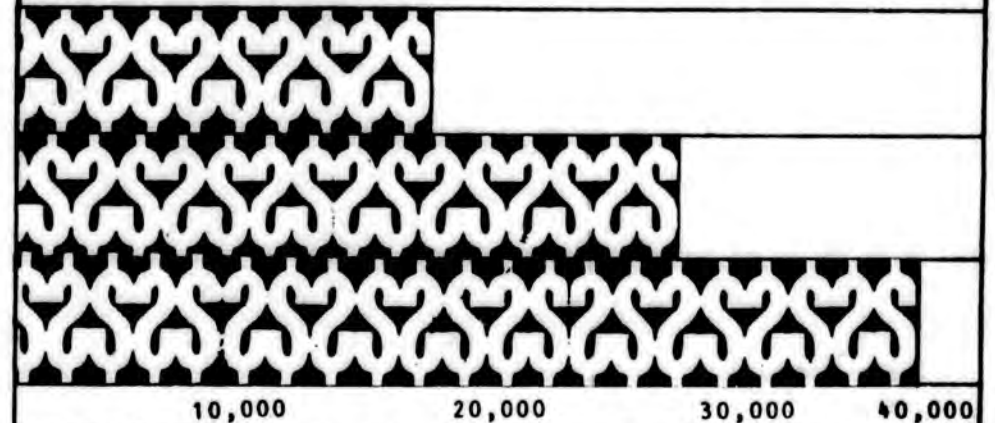
Pupil-Teacher Ratio



PUPIL/TEACHER RATIOS:

Consistent Drop in number of students per teacher in City/Borough districts. A dramatic drop in PTR between 1974-75 and 1979-80 for REAAs due to establishment of new schools with small enrollments. Slight increase for REAAs in last 5 years although overall statewide average has shown steady decrease in number of students per teacher.

AVERAGE TEACHER SALARIES:

Steady Increase overall as teachers negotiate ever-larger salary/benefit packages; up 124.8% over the 10-year period.

Explanation of Headings

Page 1

BASE, TOP, BEGINNING MASTER'S - Base and top salaries indicates lowest and highest salaries on the schedule. Beginning Master's is the pay given to a teacher with a master's degree only and no experience.

RANGE OF INDEX - Factor used as multiplier to indicate the range from the lowest to the highest salary on the salary schedule.

NUMBER OF STEPS - This step reflects the number of years of service given credit for each education level on the salary schedule. For purposes of counting, the first step has been considered zero.

MAX SCHEDULE ED LEVEL - This represents the highest level of education that is recognized on the salary schedule for pay purposes.

LONGEVITY INCREMENTS PAID - Special provision made to reward teachers who have exceeded the available number of steps, without moving to a new column on the schedule by virtue of increased education.

AVERAGE TEACHER SALARY - This figure represents the actual average teacher salary paid in each district, and is shown as average salary only, average salary with retirement benefits, and average salary with all benefits included.

% OF TOTAL SALARY FOR BENEFITS - This figure reflects the percentage of payroll used by school districts to budget for cost of fringe benefits.

% OF TEACHERS AT MAXIMUM SALARY STEP - Estimated percentage of teachers who are at the maximum step of their educational column.

Page 2

PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION OF TEACHERS ON SALARY SCHEDULE - This report indicates a number of arbitrarily defined ranges of pay and shows the percentage of teachers in each district who fall within each range.

TOTAL FTE TEACHERS - Total Full Time Equivalent Teachers in the district.

Page 3

TOTAL \$ HOSP/MED SINGLE & FAMILY - Total cost of a hospital/medical insurance policy for a single teacher or for a teacher with a family.

DIST CONTRIB HOSP/MED SINGLE & FAMILY - Represents the amount of the district contribution toward the purchase of each of those hospital/medical insurance policies. In most instances the district picks up 100% of the cost.

AMOUNT OF LIFE INSURANCE COVERAGE PER TEACHER - Represents the maximum amount of life insurance coverage the districts purchase for teachers. In some cases this was reported by districts in terms of contract language i.e. "twice the amount of the annual salary". This was reported here as twice the maximum salary on the salary schedule.

Page 3

DISABILITY INSURANCE - This represents the annual per teacher cost to the district of any disability (income protection) plan provided in addition to the basic AD&D included in major medical insurance.

PROF LIABILITY INSURANCE - Annual per teacher cost of a personal liability plan that is in addition to their general liability coverage.

TRAVEL INSURANCE - Annual per teacher cost of a life insurance plan that covers the employee while on district travel, if provided by the district.

Page 4

NON-BUSINESS TRAVEL ALLOWED - Indicates if the school district provides any travel to and/or from the district, other than school business related, as a fringe benefit to the teacher (i.e. "turnaround leave", etc.)

TRAVEL \$ PER TEACHER - Amount of dollars allowed per teacher for non-business travel, if it is provided as a fringe benefit.

SEVERANCE PAY - A additional payment that is made upon termination.

EARLY RETIREMENT - An incentive bonus given for early retirement.

TAX SHELTERED ANNUITY - Indicates that the district administratively handles the monthly arrangement for payment into a tax sheltered annuity for teachers who participate.

DISTRICT CONTRIBUTION PER TEACHER - Reflects an amount that the district contributes toward a tax sheltered annuity for the teacher.

TUITION REIMBURSEMENT PER CREDIT HOUR - Provision to reimburse tuition costs for a specified number of credit hours.

TOTAL TUITION PER TEACHER - Indicates the amount made available for each teacher for tuition reimbursement.

HOUSING ALLOWANCE AMOUNT - This figure represents the amount of reimbursement given directly to the teacher for housing costs.

DISTRICT HOUSING AVAILABLE - A yes in this column indicates the district is involved in providing housing to some or all of its teachers, either for a fee or at no cost to the teacher.

TOTAL NET REVENUE FROM DISTRICT HOUSING - This figure reflects the difference between revenues and expenditures involved in providing district housing. Expenditures include maintenance, utilities, and other associated costs. In certain instances districts reported revenues or expenditures, but not both. This results in large and misleading positive or negative figures. More accurate information was not available.

SUB PAY CERT - Substitute teachers' pay for persons with a teaching certificate.

SUB PAY - NON-CERT - Substitute teachers' pay for persons who do not hold a teaching certificate.

SL BANK DAYS PER TEACHER - Maximum number of days a teacher can (cont.) draw from the sick leave bank. Indeterminate numbers are indicated with a plus (+).

MAX DAYS CUM IN SL BANK - Maximum number of days that can be accumulated in the sick leave bank.

PERS LV DAYS PER TEACHER - Number of days available to each teacher annually for use for personal leave.

MAX PERS LV CUM PER TEACHER - Maximum number of personal leave days a teacher may accumulate from year to year.

PERS LV CASHED IN? - Answers in the column indicate 1) if the district allows personal leave to be cashed in and 2) if so, how many of the accumulated days will be given credit on a cash-in.

A - J - Various types of leave that might be made available. Answers in each of these columns with a Y/# indicates that the district provides this leave and shows the number of days, if any which may be accumulated. A legend is provided on the page of this report identifying the types of leave each letter represents.

YEARS SERVED BEFORE SABBAT - Minimum years a teacher must be employed by a district before being eligible for a sabbatical leave.

SABBAT % OF SALARY OR FLAT AMOUNT - If the teacher is to receive pay while on a sabbatical leave, the figure in this column gives the percentage of the teacher's pay or a flat amount, provided by the district.

TOTAL ASSOC DAYS AVAIL - Indicates the total number of days available to members of the representative teachers association for association business.

ASSOC PAYS SUBS? (AFTER # OF DAYS) - If the negotiated agreement requires the teachers association to pay for substitutes for teachers on association business, it is reflected in this column and indicates the number of days that are paid by the district before it becomes the teachers association responsibility.

ANY PRE-CREDITED LEAVE? - If any type of leave may be used before it is actually earned, it is reported in this column. An "S", "PER", or "PRO" following the Y/ indicates the pre-credited leave allowed is sick leave, personal leave or professional leave.

** STATEWIDE AND REGIONAL AVERAGES - In cases where averages are reported for categories by region or on a statewide basis, the averages include only districts which actually reported information in those categories.

Explanation of Headings

EXTRA DUTY SALARIES - SELECTED ACTIVITIES - Salaries listed on this page have usually been reported as the maximum amount of compensation a district makes available for responsibilities in each extra-duty category.

K, 1-6, 7-12, TOTAL ENROLL - Figures in these columns reflect the enrollment figures reported for Kindergarten, Grades 1-6, Grades 7-12, and total district enrollment.

K, 1-6, 7-12, TOTAL CLASSROOM TEACHERS - An accounting of the number of teachers in each grade level grouping. (Includes itinerant teachers.) These figures are not reported as full time equivalents.

TOTAL OTHER INSTRUCTIONAL PERSONNEL - This figure represents instructional personnel not in the classroom setting and not in administration. It includes librarians, counselors, psychologists, audio-visual, bilingual coordinators, speech therapists, consultants and supervisors, excluding aides.

TOTAL INSTRUCTIONAL AIDES - Reflects the total number of instructional aides, full time and part-time, employed by the district. This is not reported as full time equivalents.

TOTAL FTE CERTIFICATED STAFF - Full time equivalent figure for all teachers and other instructional staff who are certificated.

TOTAL FTE AIDES - Full time equivalent figure for all instructional aides employed in the district.

STUDENT CONTACT DAYS - Indicates the number of days teachers work when students are actually in attendance.

ADDITIONAL WORK DAYS - Includes days used for in-service, teachers convention, or other days when students are not in attendance, for which teachers are paid.

TOTAL CONTRACT DAYS - Total number of days for which a teacher is paid, provided for by the regular teacher contract.

MIDDLE SCHOOL - Indicates if the district uses the class grouping of "Middle School" (Grades 6,7,& 8) rather than the structure of K-6 for elementary, and 7-12 for secondary.

TEACHERS PER INSTRUCTIONAL AIDE - The figure shown here gives the ratio of teachers per instructional aide. It was not figured on full time equivalency, but simply on the total number of individuals employed as teachers and as instructional aides.

STUDENTS PER CLASSROOM TEACHER - Ratio of students to classroom teacher on a district-wide basis. These numbers are not reported as full time equivalents.

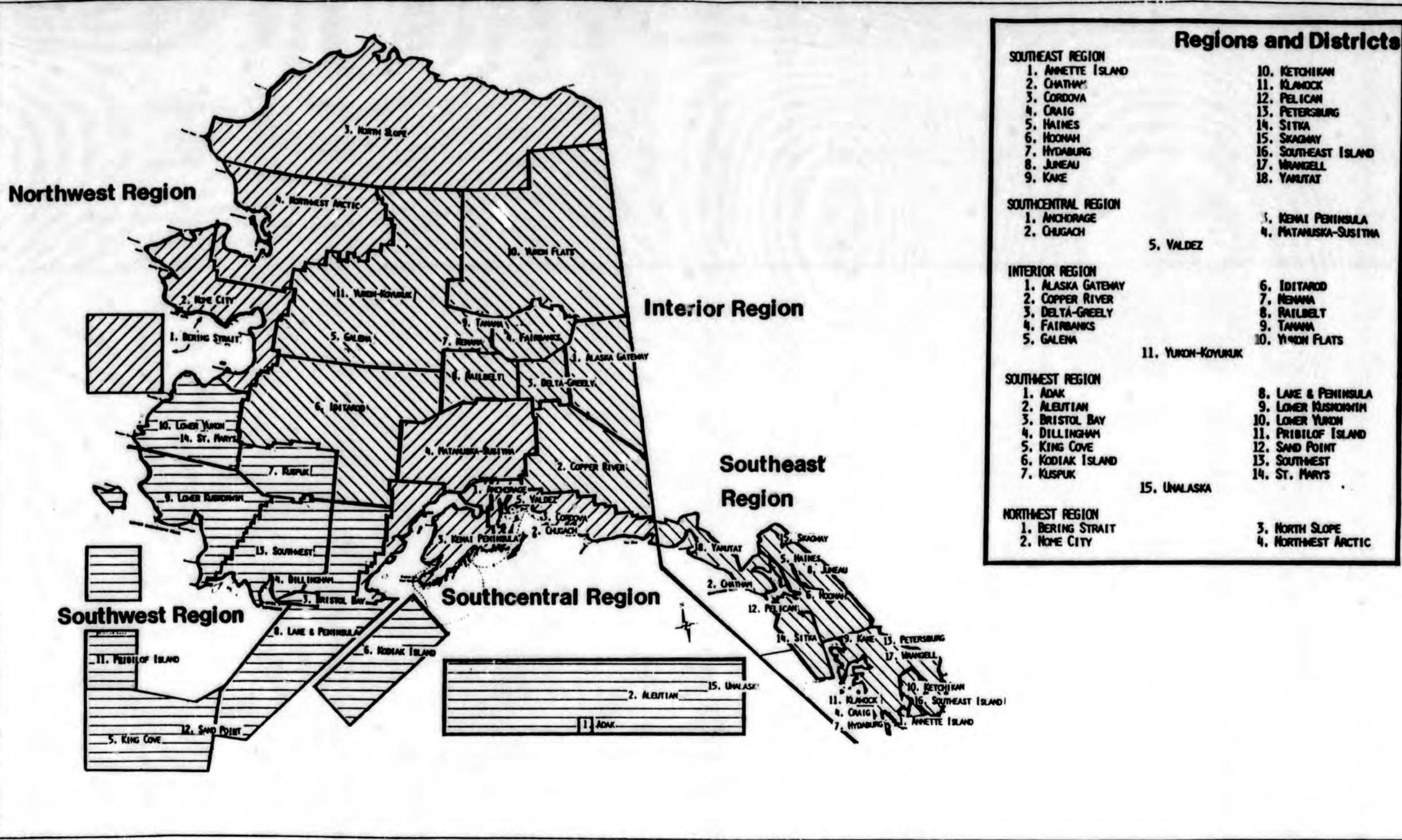
